Question # 167: What is the Lord's Supper?

Answer:

The Lord's supper is a sacrament of the New Testament,^a wherein, by giving and receiving bread and wine according to the appointment of Jesus Christ, his death is shewed forth; and they that worthily communicate feed upon his body and blood, to their spiritual nourishment and growth in grace;^b have their union and communion with him confirmed;^c testify and renew their thankfulness,^d and engagement to God,^e and their mutual love and fellowship each with other, as members of the same mystical body.^f
