Intro: John's purpose in writing this gospel Jn. 20:30-31

- He is very selective
- The significance of the sign miracles
- The "Gospel of Belief"

John's unique prologue 1:1-18

1. Our Lord's Unique Identity as "The Word"

"In the beginning was the Word"

- (1) "Word" Gk: LOGOS
 - conveyed not only the expression of an idea, but the idea itself
 - describes God in the process of self-communication

(2) Christ is the very revelation of God

In order to perfectly reveal an infinite person you must yourself be possessed of an infinite nature!

2. Our Lord's Perfections as "The Word"

(1) His Eternal Pre-existence

"In the beginning was the Word"

- Prior to creation, prior to time, Christ the Word already existed
- He existed from all eternity

(2) His Perfect Familiarity with Deity

"and the Word was with God"

- Gk: pros ton theon very literally: the Word was "face to face with God"
 - cf. Mk. 6:3 "Are not His sisters here with us?"
 - i.e., "We know them! We are entirely familiar with them!"
- Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Word, existed from all eternity in a relationship of total familiarity with God!
- Our Lord, the Word, was and is a distinct Person within the blessed holy undivided Trinity
- (3) His Equality of Nature with Deity

"and the Word was God.

He was in the beginning with God"

-1- "the Word was in essence, God."

- a direct, perfect expression of deity
- John the Apostle used the exact expression necessary to convey true deity.

-2- He was from all eternity with God

- assertion of triunity
- distinction of Persons, but a unity from all eternity

(4) His Glory as Creator

v. 3 "All things were made through Him,

and without Him nothing was made that was made."

-1- Everything that is created was created by Him

- Everything that has a beginning point, an origin, owes its existence to Him.
- Mark carefully the great Creator/creature distinction!

-2- The creative work of the Word: a revelation of God

- Rom. 1 "His eternal power and divine nature are clearly seen"
- The Divine signature in all creation renders all men without excuse. cf. Rom. 1

(5) His Glory as the Source of All Life

vv. 4-5

-1- True Life - spiritual life

"In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

And the light shines in the darkness,

and the darkness did not comprehend it."

He is the source of true life and true life is revealed only in Him

-2- True Light - spiritual light, moral light:

Light such that one can know God and commune with God He is the source of true light and true light is revealed only by Him.

 $\hbox{-3-This true light shines into our sin-darkened world, infinitely superior to all darkness!}\\$

- cf. 2 Cor. 4:6
