300 years of severe persecution from Emperors Nero (AD 54-68) to Diocletian (AD 284-305).

"Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted" 2 Timothy 3:12

What are some ways that we face persecution in our day?

- 1. People won't like us.
- 2. People will disagree with us, or argue with us.
- 3. People might get angry, or even violent with us.
- 4. People will exclude us, ignore us, or avoid us altogether.
- 5. People won't hire us, or promote us at work. We could even get fired.
- 6. People will tell us not to talk about our faith at work, in school, or in other public places.

The public proclamation of the Gospel immediately divides people into one of only two categories:

- 1) those who are drawn by the truth in God's Word, and to the Person of Christ it reveals;
- 2) those who are repulsed by the truth in God's Word, and by the Person of Christ it reveals.
