The book of Acts cites five trips that Paul made to Jerusalem:

1. The first visit was after his conversion on the road to Damascus and after three years of revelation in Arabia (Acts 9:26-30; Gal. 1:18-20).
2. The second visit was the “famine visit,” bringing financial aid to the Judean believers (Acts 11:27-30; 12:25).
3. The third visit was to attend the “Jerusalem Counsel” (Acts 15:1-30) as part of the delegation from the church in Antioch.
4. The fourth visit was at the end of his second missionary journey (Acts 18:22).
5. The fifth visit was at the end of his third missionary journey that resulted in his Caesarean imprisonment and deportation to Rome (Acts 21:15-23:35).
