## Introduction

- "light amplification by stimulated emission of radiation"—LASER
- Examples of the use of LASERS in everyday life
- Power of light in communication industry—Fiber Optics
- Jesus as the "Light of the World"
  - Personal, final revelation of God to mankind
  - Expresses God's holiness and exposes man's sinfulness
  - Opens spiritually impaired eyes and blinds spiritually proud

## The Power of Light

- A. As the "Light of the World", Jesus Christ leads us from the realm of spiritual darkness to the realm of spiritual light—and in the process, He transforms our lives!
  - 1. Jesus invites us to "follow" Him
    - a. The Feast of Tabernacles and the Lamp Lighting celebration
    - b. What is involved in "following" Christ?
      - 1) To "follow" is to "believe in the light"—John 12:34-36
      - 2) To "follow" is to "follow" His lead—Matthew 16:24
  - 2. When we "follow" Jesus...
    - a. We no longer live in the realm of darkness—John 12:46
    - b. We have the "light of life"—transformation of person
      - 1) Once "darkness"—Ephesians 5:8
      - 2) Now "light" in the Lord—"sons of light"
- B. As those transformed by His light, we become "light", reflecting His light in this world. Ephesians 5:3-16
  - First Question: Why is our light so dim?

Answer: Failure to act like who we are!

- a. Positional Truth vs. Practical Reality
- b. Need to live like "children of light"
- 2. Second Question: How can we increase our spiritual lumens?
  - a. If we are to be "light" in the world, we must be "separate" from the world. Ephesians 5:3-7
    - 1) World's perverted ideas of "LOVE"—LUST
      - a. Works—fornication, uncleanness, covetousness
      - b. Words—filthiness, foolish talk, jesting
    - 2) Need to be different from the world—Eph. 5:3; 4:17-20
    - 3) Does not mean isolation, but insulation—1 Cor. 5:9-10
