PRIESTLY BLESSING - Luke 24:50-53

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Luke ends w/ Ascension no other Gospel ends w/ Ascension.
 - i. <u>Lk 24:50-53</u> & <u>A 1:9-12</u>. LK records the event of ascension but other NT writers acknowledge the fact & significance of ascension
- 2. Phil Ryken: "Do we understand that even the joys of Easter Sunday are surpassed by the glories of the ascension?" [692]

1st: What is Jesus Doing?

1. <u>Lk 24:50-53</u> - repeated word: *blessing* = main action in v50-51 & 52-53.

2nd: What is Luke Doing?

- 1. Luke writes an account Lk 1:1-4. Historical, theolgical, pastoral.
- 2. The "inclusio" of Luke. Compare beginning & ending of Luke. Angels, worshipers, temple, priest.

3rd: The Aaronic Priestly Blessing

- 1. Completion of tabernacle Ex 40:34-38. Sac'al worship accepted.
- 02. Lev 9:22-24 1st occasion of Aaron's service definitve. Note description.
- 3. Custom of priestly blessing. Sirach 54:15-16; 50:19-21.

4. What did Priest say to *bless* the people? Num 6:22-27

4th: Zacharias' Priestly Blessing

- 1. <u>Lk 1</u> recount Zacharias & Gabriel <u>v21-23</u>. Where's the blessing?
 - i. 1st occasion of bless Lk 1:39-48
 - ii. next occasion Lk 1:67-79 Priestly blessing given outside temple?
- 2. See juxtaposition of the literary bracket of Luke.

5th: Jesus' Priestly Blessing

- 1. <u>Lk 24:50-53</u> <u>Lev 9:22-24</u> <u>Num 6:22-27</u> The unprecedented accomplishment of our redemption justifies seeing Jesus as our Priest.
- 2. Note similarities & differences progress into resurrection glory.

Applic #1: Priestly Blessing is Given When Priestly Sacrifice Has Been Accepted

1. OCov priests wore bells - Exo 28:35. How we need to know that atonement for our sin has been made & accepted!

- 2. With the priest's blessing, the people know that the Lord will continue to live w/ them in order to bless them: forgiveness life.
- **3.** Do you understand the significance of Jesus' Priestly blessing? Is Jesus your sacrifical lamb [Jn 1:29]? your Priest? Are you *blessed*?
