"Holy And Just And Good" Romans 7:7-12

Introduction:

- 1. The Ten Commandments:
 - Have Fallen On Hard Times It Would Seem!
 - In 2005 There Was A Concern That:
 - The Display Of The Ten Commandments:
 - In Two Courthouses In The State Of Kentucky:
 - Violated The "Establishment Clause" Of The First Amendment Of The US Constitution!

- In Response:
 - The US Supreme Court:
 - Made A Controversial 5-4 Ruling:
 - That Prohibits The Ten Commandments To Be Displayed In Court Buildings Or On Government Property!
 - However They Added:
 - As Stated In One Article:
 - "The Biblical laws *could* be displayed in an historical context, as they are in a frieze [wall decoration] in the Supreme Court building. Notably, [however] the first four commandments, which have to do with honoring God and the Sabbath, were obscured by the artist who designed the frieze!"
- 2. Yes The Ten Commandments:
 - Have Fallen On Hard Times!
 - But This Is Not Just Because:
 - Of Secularists & Atheists:
 - Who Want Any And All References To The God Of The Bible:
 - Obliterated From Society!
 - I Believe It Is Also Because:
 - Of How Some Who Claim To Hold To The Tenets Of God's Law: Even Christians:
 - Have *Treated* God's Law:
 - Both Now And In The Past!
 - Not Only Is God's Law:
 - Routinely *Infringed Against*:
 - By Disobeying Them!
 - Most Of The Time God's Law:
 - Is Roundly *Ignored*:
 - As If It Has No Relevance!
- 3. And Even Some Christians & Churches:
 - Will Appeal To The Writings Of The Apostle Paul:
 - For Their Support!
 - They Will Turn To Some Of The Same Passages:
 - That We've Already Looked At:
 - In The Book Of Romans!
 - For Example They Will Cite:
 - Romans 3:20 Which Says:
 - "Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight!"
 - So The Law Of God:
 - Has No Bearing On:
 - Your Justification Before God Which Is True!
 - And Then They Will Cite:
 - Romans 6:14 Which Says That:
 - -"Ye are not under the law, but under grace!"
 - So The Law Of God:
 - Has No Dominion In The Reign Of God's Grace:
 - Which Is Also Partly True!
 - Or They Will Also Cite:
 - Romans 7:4 & 6 Where We Were Last Week:

- Which Says That: - We Have "Become Dead To The Law!" - And Now - "We Are Delivered From The Law!" - Which Are Also True! So - How, Then, Are We To Take: - The Law Of God? - His Moral Law - As Revealed To Us Especially: - In The Ten Commandments? - Well - This Is What The Apostle Paul Takes Up Next: - In Romans 7! - And - The Reason Why: - God's Law Has Fallen On Hard Times: - Even In The Lives Of Christians And: - The Teachings Of Churches: - Is Because They / And Perhaps Even We: - Don't Read Far Enough! - Because - In Romans 7:7-12 - Paul Addresses A Major Concern: - About God's Law: - "What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet. / But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead. / For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died. / And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death. / For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me. / Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good!" Paul Knew That: - What He Had Already Written: - About God's Law: - Could Easily Be Taken The Wrong Way: - Even To The Point Where:

- God's Law Could Be Considered The Very Cause Of Sin!
 - "Is The Law Sin?"
- Because If What Paul Wrote:
 - Is True About:
 - The Dominion Of The Law!
 - Our Death To The Law! And:
 - Our Deliverance From The Law!
 - Then It Would Seem That The Law:
 - Is More A Tool In The Devil's Tool-Box Than In God's!
 - So "Is The Law Sin?"
- Well Without Giving This Question:
 - Even A Second Thought:
 - Paul Answers Unequivocally:
 - "God Forbid!" Or:
 - "May It Never Be!"
 - This Question:
 - Is Actually *Out* Of The Question:
 - Because The Law Of God:
 - Reflects:
 - His Own Nature!
 - And Forever Remains:
 - His Own Servant!
- And So Under The Inspiration: 6.
 - Of God Himself God The Holy Spirit:
 - Paul Explains The True Nature:
 - Of God's Moral Law!
 - And We Need To Remember These Truths:
 - Lest God's Law Falls On Hard Times In Our Own Lives As Well!

* Because - The First Thing We See About God's Law Is: The Great Exposure Of God's Law! - The Great Exposure - That Is: - What God's Law Actually Exposes! - 7:7 - "What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet!" - God's Law Exposes Sin! - It Exposes: - What Sin Is And What Sin Does! - IE: When A Journalist Writes A Story About Crime And Corruption In High Places - It Is Often Called An Expose - Because It Is Bringing To Light Things That Were Hidden From View! - And - This Is What God's Law Is: - It Is God's On Expose On Sin: - Bringing To Light Those Things That Are Done In Darkness! - And - The Apostle Paul: - Understood This Personally: - Because Of How God Used The Law: - To Open His Eyes: - To His Own Sin Against God! - So - All Throughout Chapter 7: - Paul Writes In The First Person: - To Share His Own Personal Testimony! - But - In Doing So: - He Shows How God Works In The Hearts Of All Men: - Through The Power Of His Word & His Law! - So - He Reveals: - The Illumination Of God's Law: - In 7:7 - When He Writes: - "I had not known sin, but by the law!" - God Used His Law: - To Show Paul: - The True Nature Of Sin In His Life! - And This Is Necessary: - Because - For A Sinner: - Sin Isn't Sin! - Sin Is Natural: - For A Sinner! - Sin Is Normal: - To A Sinner! And: - Sin Is Even Necessary: - For A Sinner! - So - God Devised A Way: - To Break Into Our Hearts & Minds: - As Sinners - In Order To: - Illuminate Our Understanding: - Of Sin! - And So - He Gave Us: - His Law! - So - God's Law: - Doesn't Conceal Sin! God's Law: - Doesn't Condone Sin! - And - God's Law Certainly: - Doesn't Cause Sin! - No - Instead - It Exposes Sin:

- And Illuminates The Nature Of Sin:

- Within The Conscience Of A Sinner! - Sinners Like Paul & Us!

- But Then - Paul Further Reveals:

- The Illustration Of God's Law:
 - In The Rest Of 7:7 When He Specifically Focuses On:
 - The Tenth Commandment Of Gods Law:
 - "For I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet!"
 - Once Again The Apostle Paul:
 - Is Giving His Personal Testimony Here:
 - And In Effect He Is Saying That:
 - God Used The Tenth Commandment To Break Into His Hard Heart And Expose The True Nature Of His Sinful Condition!
 - You See Before His Conversion To Jesus Christ:
 - Paul Had Been A Faithful & A Fervent Jew!
 - He Was Much Like The Rich Young Ruler In Matthew 19 Who When Confronted With By Jesus With A List Of The Commandments Said:
 - "All These Things Have I Kept From My Youth: What Lack I Yet?" (19:20)
 - To Paul God's Law Was Like A Check-List!
 - He Could Go Through Them One At A Time:
 - And Say:
 - I Believe And Worship God!
 - I Don't Take His Name In Vain!
 - I Remember The Sabbath!
 - I Honor My Parents!
 - I've Never Killed Anyone!
 - I've Never Committed Adultery!
 - I've Never Stolen!
 - And I Don't Lie!
 - But He Didn't Understand:
 - The True Nature Of God's Law:
 - Until God Opened His Eyes & Heart:
 - To The Tenth Commandment:
 - Which Reveals That Sin Is Not Just Something You Do On The Outside:
 - It Is Something That Begins In The Heart!
 - You See Lust & Covetousness:
 - Is The "Root Of All Sins!"
 - And When Confronted With This Commandment:
 - The Self-Righteous Pharisee That Paul Was:
 - Understood His True Nature For The First Time And The True Nature Of Sin!
- God's Law Exposes Sin!
 - And This Is A Good Thing For A Sinner!
 - Because This Is Exactly What Needs To Happen To You:
 - Before You Can Cry Out To God:
 - For The Help & Deliverance You Need!
 - "God Be Merciful To Me A Sinner!" (Lk. 18:13)
 - The First Step In Repentance From Sin:
 - Is The Realization Of Sin!
 - And When God Exposes Your Sin:
 - Through His Word & Through His Commandments:
 - It Means That God Himself Is At Work!
- * But Then Sadly Paul Reveals Something Else And That Is:
- 2. The Great Exploitation Of God's Law!
 - The Great Exploitation That Is:
 - What Sin Does With God's Law!
 - **IE:** When Sin Is Exposed By God And His Law It Will Not Be Exposed Without A Fight! Like The Man Who Ran Last Week From The Authorities Not Far From Here When They Went To Arrest Him!
 - This Is What Sin Is Like When It Is Exposed To The Law Of God!

- 7:8-11 "But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead. / For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died. / And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death. / For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me!"
 - In Verses 8 & 11 We Find The Same Phrase:
 - "But / For Sin Taking Occasion By The Commandment!"
- The Commandment Paul Is Referring To:
 - Is The Tenth Commandment:
 - That Really Hit Home With Him:
 - In His Conscience!
 - But What God Meant For Good:
 - The Devil Sought To Use:
 - For Even More Evil:
 - And To Entrap Paul In His Sin!
- This Is What It Means When It Says That:
 - "Sin" Was "Taking Occasion By The Commandment!"
 - Sin Which Is Personified Here:
 - Saw Its Chance & Took The Opportunity:
 - To Use God's Own Law:
 - For Its Own Nefarious Purposes!
- And The First Way:
 - Sin Exploits God's Law:
 - Is That:
- Sin Defiles Us!
 - 7:8a "But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence!"
 - "Concupiscence" Here Is The Same Word:
 - For "Lust" In 7:7!
 - Basically When God Told Paul:
 - Through The Tenth Commandment:
 - "Thou Shalt Not Covet Lust!"
 - Then Sin Woke Up From Its Slumber Within Him:
 - And Stirred Up In His Heart All Kinds Of Lusts And Wicked Desires!
 - IE: Like A Child Doing The Exact Opposite Of What It Is Told! Or An Adult! Or You! Or Me!
 - Our Indwelling Sin:
 - Stirs Us Up & Stimulates Us:
 - To Sin Even More:
 - When We Are Confronted With The Law Of God!
 - But There Is Another Way:
 - That Sin Exploits God's Law As Well!
 - As We Find In 7:11:
- Sin Deceives Us!
 - 7:11a "For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me!"
 - Sin Is Deceitful!
 - Because Like The Serpent In The Garden Of Eden:
 - It Masks The Deadly Poison Of Its Venomous Bite:
 - With Luscious Lies!
 - Isn't This What Happened:
 - In The Garden Of Eden:
 - To Our Earliest Mother Eve?
 - In Genesis 3:1-5:
 - The Devil Tempted Eve:
 - To Doubt God His Nature & His Word By Deceiving Her!
 - "Yea, Hath God Said?"
 - The Serpent Asked!
 - "Ye Shall Not Surely Die!"
 - The Serpent Adds! And:
 - "God Doth Know That Ye Shall Be As Gods!"
 - The Serpent Said!

- The Sin Of The Serpent:
 - Will Always Lie To You & Deceive You!
- It Will Claim To You That:
 - Its Promises:
 - Are Better Than:
 - God's Promises!
- It Will Try To Convince You That:
 - It's Pleasures:
 - Are Greater Than:
 - God's Pleasure!
- But Once You Take That Bite:
 - You Will Find That:
 - The Pleasures Of Sin:
 - Only Last For A Season! And:
 - The Promise Of Sin:
 - Is A Lie And Instead Of Life:
 - Leads To Death!
- And Sin Will Use God's Laws & Commandments:
 - Which God Designed As A Tool:
 - To Awaken Your Conscience:
 - To Your Sinfulness & Neediness!
 - And It Will Turn Them Against You:
 - As A Weapon:
 - To Bludgeon Your Soul:
 - Into Further Submission To Its Wicked Will!
- God's Law Is Exploited By Sin!
 - And This Very Fact:
 - Shows To Us That:
 - God's Law Must Be A Good Thing!
 - Otherwise Why Would Sin Be So Threatened By It?
 - But Right In The Middle:
 - Of This Description By Paul:
 - Of How Sin Exploits God's Law:
 - He Adds:

3. The Great Experience Of God's Law!

- The Great Experience Of God's Law:
 - In His Own Life!
 - 7:8b-10 "For without the law sin was dead. / For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died. / And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death!"
 - Here Is Paul's Personal Testimony:
 - Of How God Used The Law:
 - In His Own Life!
 - Because At First He Was Living A Relatively:
- Carefree Life!
 - 7:8b-9a "For without the law sin was dead. / For I was alive without the law once!"
 - Paul Is Not Here Talking About:
 - Spiritual Death & Life:
 - As We Are Most Familiar With From His Writings!
 - He Is Describing His Experience:
 - As A Faithful & A Fervent Jew:
 - Who Was Very Ambitious He Thought:
 - For God!
 - He Was Living His Life:
 - According To His Own:
 - Aims & Aspirations!
 - In Philippians 3:5-6 He Writes:

- "Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; / Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless!"
- And So As Far As He Was Concerned:
 - He Was AOK With God!
 - He Felt Secure & Satisfied:
 - And Under No Conviction Of Personal Sin!
- Sin Seemed So Dead To Him:
 - And He Felt So Alive!
 - Perhaps This Is How Someone Here Or is Listening Feels Today!
 - But This Is A Dangerous Condition For A Sinner!
 - And This Is Why God Gave Us His Law!
- Because Somewhere Along The Way:
 - Paul's Carefree Life Turned Into A:
- Confronted Life!
 - 7:9b "But when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died!"
 - God In His Grace:
 - Confronted Paul:
 - By Using His Law Like A Hammer:
 - To Crush & To Humble His Proud Heart!
 - And When God Started:
 - Awakening Paul's Conscience:
 - To The Internal Sin In Paul's Heart:
 - Paul's Carefree Life:
 - Was Over!
 - "Sin Revived" Paul Says!
 - This Means That:
 - Not Only Did God Bring Him To A Greater Awareness Of His Sin:
 - But Sin Itself Realized That The Fight Was On Again:
 - For The Soul Of Paul!
 - You See The Normal Life:
 - Of A Sinner Without Christ:
 - Is A Life:
 - Without Concern Or Care:
 - For The Things Of God!
 - But When God Breaks Through:
 - With His Law:
 - The Devil Knows His Purpose:
 - And The Devil Knows His Power!
 - So Sin Is Reactivated:
 - In A More Powerful Way!
 - And That Is Why Paul Adds:
 - "And I Died!"
 - He Started To Feel:
 - The Soul-Crushing Weight:
 - Of Doubt And Distress And Despair:
 - Caused By Sin!
 - John Gill "He Saw Himself As A Dead Man, Dead In Sin, Dead In Law, Under A Sentence Of Death All His Hopes Of Eternal Life By His Obedience To The Law Died At Once!"
 - Perhaps These Were Some Of:
 - "The Pricks" That He Was Kicking Against:
 - Before Jesus Called Him:
 - To Faith And To Life:
 - On The Road To Damascus!
 - But Sin Kept Driving Him:
 - Into A Greater Hopelessness:
 - In His Sin!
 - "God Can't Save You!"

- "You Are Too Far Gone!"
 "There's No Hope For You!"
 And So Paul Further Experienced A:
- Condemned Life!
 - 7:10 "And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death!"
 - This Too Was The Experience Of That Early German Reformer Of The Church:
 - Martin Luther!

- "Martin Luther Was Struggling To Obey The Ten Commandments. Somebody Told Him: 'Why Don't You Just Concentrate On Loving God?' Martin Luther Fired Back At Him: 'Love God? Sometimes I Hate Him!'"

- This Is Often:
 - The Experience Of God's Law:
 - In The Lives Of Sinners!
 - *This* Is Why People Want:
 - The Ten Commandments:
 - Out Of The Courtrooms!
 - This Is Why People:
 - Don't Want To Hear About:
 - The Law Of God!
 - Because God Uses His Law:
 - To Break Into:
 - Your Quiet & Care-Free Conscience!
 - But When This Happens:
 - Its A Good Thing!
 - Because It Means That God Is At Work!
- Because It Reveals That:
 - Your Only Hope:
 - Can Be Found In God:
 - And His Righteousness:
 - Not In Yourself:
 - And Your Own Self-Righteousness!
 - You Need A Savior!
 - And That Savior Is Jesus Christ!
 - But This Leads Paul & Us To:
- 4. The Great Essence Of God's Law!
 - The Great Essence:
 - Which We Find In:
 - 7:12 "Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good!
 - In Answer To The Question:
 - Of 7:7 "Is The Law Sin?"
 - This Is The Answer!
 - 7:12 "Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good!"
 - You See:
 - The Nature Of The Law:
 - Reflects & Reveals To Us:
 - The Nature Of The Giver Of The Law:
 - God Himself!
 - So The Essence Of God's Law:
 - As A Whole:
 - Is That It Is:
 - Holy!
- "Wherefore the law is holy!"
- To Be "Holy" Means:
 - To Be Set Apart & Special!
 - And This Describes God And His Law!
 - It Is Perfect:
 - And Complete!

- It Is Pure: - Without Defilement! - It Is Purposeful: - With A Special Design To Accomplish God's Will! - John Gill - "It Is A Transcript Of The Holy Nature Of God, A Declaration Of His Holy Will!" - But - Even More: - The Essence Of God's Law: - In Its Parts: - Is That It Is: - Holy And Just And Good! - Holy! - In That Each Commandment: - Is Perfect And Pure: - Forming A Tapestry That Reveals God's Own Character and Will! - Because - That Which Pleases Him Is Like Unto Him! - It Is Also: - Just! - Like God: - His Commandments: - Are No Respecter Of Persons! - They Are Clear: - And They Are Fair! - They Apply To Each Person: - Equally! - They Are Also Changeless: - And Immutable: - They Are Not Arbitrary! - And So - They Are Also: - Good! - God's Commandments Are Truly: - A Beautiful Thing! - They Radiate the Beauty Of God's On Character: - And Reveal His Love For The Creatures He Has Made! - They Are Good! Because They Are Also: - A Beneficial Thing! - In Fact - It Is What God Uses: - To Point To The Only One Who Can Give Us Hope! - Galatians 3:24 - "Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith!" - This Is The Great Essence Of God's Law!

Conclusion:

- 1. So Don't Let The Law Of God:
 - Fall On Hard Times:
 - In Your Own Heart And Life!
 - And Don't Let Your Sin:

- It Is Holy And Just And Oh, So Good!

- Exploit God's Law:
 - By Causing You To Think That There Is No Hope For You!
- 2. Because This Is Why Jesus Came!
 - 1 Timothy 1:15 "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief!"
 - Now How Did Paul Come To Know:
 - That He Was The "Chiefest" Of Sinners?
 - Through God's Own Law!
- 3. If God Is Confronting You:
 - And Convicting You:
 - Of Your Sin Through His Law:

- And Through His Commandments:
 - That Is Good!
 - That Is Right Were You Need To Be!
- Because Then & Only Then:
 - Will You Be In The Place:
 - Where You See Your Need Of:
 - An All-Sufficient Savior:
 - And Turn To & Trust In Jesus:
 - Alone!

- 4. Don't Let Your Sin:
 - Use God's Law:
 - To Keep You From:
 - God Himself!
 - Stop Kicking Against The Pricks!
 - Instead Let God Use His Law:
 - To Draw You To Himself:
 - Through The Lord Jesus Christ!
 - Because:
 - Even Though God's Law:
 - **Does** Reveal Just How Truly **Bad**:
 - We Are!
 - It *Also* Reveals:
 - Just How Truly *Good*:
 - God Is!
 - To Send Jesus:
 - To Seek And To Save:
 - Sinners Just Like Us!

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
