God does not want us to remain there!*

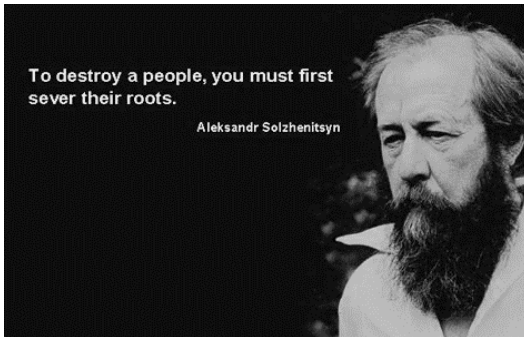
