The Way to Conclude Our Prayers

I. With Humble Awe

A. We end our prayers with humble adoration because this is the experience of those who know they have been in the presence of Almighty God.

B. This spirit of humble awe is expressed in the closing words of the Lord's Prayer.

11. With Sure Confidence

A. Our confidence is there is nothing too hard for the Lord; that He is willing and able to give us all good. Jer. 3:33; Ps. 18:6, 7, 9; I John 5:14, 15; Isaiah 40:27.

B. When we pray with this confidence, we leave a testimony about God before the world.

III. With Calming Peace

- A. We conclude our prayers with the word "Amen," which means truly and certainly.
- B. This brings us to the end of the Lord's Prayer and to the end of the HC.
