God's Judgment: Two Witnesses Revelation 11:1-13 (part two)

- I. PREPARATION: "measure the temple" (vv.1-2)
- II. <u>PROPHECY</u>: "two witnesses...will prophesy" (vv.3-6)

III. PERSECUTION: "finished their testimony" (vv.7-13)

- **A. Execution:** "the beast that came up out of the abyss" (vv.7-10)
 - 1. Resistance: "will make war with them" (v.7a)
 - 2. Retaliation: "overcome them and kill them" (v.7b)
 - 3. Revenge: "their dead bodies will lie in the street" (vv.8-9)
 - a. Disrespecting: "dead bodies...in the street"
 - b. Discerning: "look at their dead bodies for 3 and a half days"
 - c. Displaying: "will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb"
 - 4. Rejoicing: "will rejoice over them and make merry" (v.10)
- **B. Exoneration:** "the breathe of life from God came into them" (vv.11-13)
 - 1. Resurrection: "they stood on their feet" (v.11a)
 - 2. Reaction: "great fear fell upon those who were beholding them" (v.11b)
 - 3. Return: "they went up into heaven" (v.12)
 - a. Assertion: "come up here"
 - b. Ascension: "they went up"
 - c. Astonishment: "their enemies beheld them"
 - 4. Results: "great earthquake...people killed...terrified...gave glory" (v.13)
 - a. Shaking: "there was a great earthquake"
 - b. Shattering: "a tenth of the city fell"
 - c. Slaying: "7,000 people killed"
 - d. Submitting: "the rest were terrified and gave glory to God"
