1. PAUL'S TRIP TO JERUSALEM RESULTED IN AGREEMENT; PETER'S TRIP TO ANTIOCH RESULTED IN HIS REBUKE (2:11-13).

- a. Paul publicly confronted Peter (2:11-12).
- b. Peter's bad example infected all the Jews at Antioch with that gospel error (2:13).
- 2. PAUL CORRECTED PETER AND DECLARED THE TRUTH OF THE GOSPEL (2:14-21).
 - a. Paul was moved to act when he realized Peter's error (2:14).

b. Paul began his correction with Peter's knowledge of the gospel (2:15-16).
