1 THESSALONIANS – LESSON 1

"Real People Real Gospel Real City"

Acts 17:1-10 (Paul's second missionary journey 49-52ad)

17 Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where there was a synagogue of the Jews. ² Then Paul, as his custom was, went in to them, and for three Sabbaths reasoned with them from the Scriptures, ³ explaining and demonstrating that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead, and *saying*, "This Jesus whom I preach to you is the Christ." ⁴ And some of them were persuaded; and a great multitude of the devout Greeks, and not a few of the leading women, joined Paul and Silas.

⁵ But the Jews who were not persuaded, becoming envious took some of the evil men from the marketplace, and gathering a mob, set all the city in an uproar and attacked the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. ⁶ But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some brethren to the rulers of the city, crying out, "These who have turned the world upside down have come here too. ⁷ Jason has harbored them, and these are all acting contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying there is another king—Jesus." ⁸ And they troubled the crowd and the rulers of the city when they heard these things. ⁹ So when they had taken security from Jason and the rest, they let them go. ¹⁰ Then the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea.....

Thessalonica – (see map) Roman capital city (200,000) of the area located on crossroads and was a seaport. Had considerable commerce and lots of temples, many bordello's.

Paul's Timeline – Philippi – Thessalonica – Berea – Athens – Corinth. While in Corinth (about 18 months) Timothy and Silas* showed up with a report from Thessalonica. 1 Thessalonians is a response to the report.

² We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers, ^{3a} remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope ^{3b} in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,

⁴ knowing, beloved brethren, your election by God. ⁵ For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake. ⁶ And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit,

⁷ so that you became examples to all in Macedonia and Achaia who believe. ⁸ For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything.
