## III. Therefore in Ephesians – a hinge in the text

- A. There must be no separation between doctrine and practice
  - 1. Eph 4:4-6
  - 2. John 13:17 "... blessed are you if you do them."
  - 3. Ezekiel 11:19-20 "... keep my judgments and do them"
  - 4. 2 Cor 5:17 "... he is a new creation, the old is past away"
- B. How do we live AFTER the *therefore*?
  - 1. *lowliness* (humility toward God)
  - 2. *gentleness* (mild, quiet restraint before men)
  - 3. *long-suffering* (patient)
  - 4. bearing with one another in love

### IV. Application

- A. To the non- Christian
  - 1. Christ has come, *therefore* repent and believe
- B. To the Christian
  - 1. Learn how to read Scripture correctly (imperatives in light of indicatives)
  - 2. *Therefore* introduces us to the doctrine of sanctification.
  - 3. Pay attention to what comes AFTER the *therefore* and live in accordance with the exhortation
  - 4. Are you regularly living AFTER the *therefore*?
