Matthew 6:5-8 OT: Nehemiah 4:1-9

Theme: Prayer is the natural response and activity of the believer in his/her relationship with the living God. We are invited to open our lives to Him in humility and sincerity. These are the prayers that God hears and answers.

Background: As prayer has been a frequent topic in our studies recently we are going to take the next several weeks to consider the Lord's Prayer as a means to draw us more deeply into personal prayer.

Introduction: We can study something wonderful – and squeeze out the "wonder."

- I. Believers Pray
  - A. The sign of life
    - 1. The living "breathe"
      - A newborn's cry
    - 2. Those reborn "pray"
      - Crying out to God
    - 3. Learning to pray
      - "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1)
      - Not "if" but "when"
  - B. Divine communication "Prayer is the soul's breathing itself into the bosom of its heavenly Father." (Thomas Watson)
    - Taking God's promises and turning them back to Him in request knowing that
    - Communicating through the word
- II. Prayers that are not Heard (Or "How Not to Pray")
  - A. Praying for show (5)
    - 1. Hypocrites
      - Who are they? Scribes and Pharisees (Matthew 23)
      - What are they? (Matthew 23:27&28)
      - Appearance bears no resemblance to reality
    - 2. Pride is the problem
      - a. They "love" the limelight (5)
        - Luke 18:10ff
      - b. Making my private prayer "public"
  - B. More "Words" than Prayer
    - 1. Empty phrases? Vain repetition
      - -The "pitter-patter" of the "Pater Noster"
      - 1 Kings 18:26 from "morning till noon"

NOTE: Not all repetition is "vain." See Psalm 136 or Matthew 26:44

- 2. Too many words
  - a. Why so many words??
    - A god in my image needs to understand my request
  - b. "Lip service"
    - An offering of the lips, not the heart
    - Going through the motions

NOTE: It is not much prayer that is rejected – but many words in prayer. (Luke 20:46&47)

- C. A Temporal Reward
  - The eyes of the crowd is all you get

- A. With humility!
  - 1. In Secret
    - To be heard, not seen! (Matthew 14:23; Acts 10)
    - Before divinity, not humanity
  - 2. Before Him Who sees
    - in secret (Psalm 139:7-10)

NOTE: If you can't be in "secret" you still pray (Daniel 6:10&11)

- B. In sincerity
  - 1. He knows what you need
    - Before you ask!
    - Not so we can change His mind (Numbers 23:19)
  - 2. In Spirit and truth (John 4:24)
- C. Concertedly
  - Finding a time and place
- IV. Drawn to Prayer
  - A. By our own need!
    - We aren't in control
    - Aware of our weaknesses
  - B. By our God
    - 1. A great and gracious Father
    - 2. Who calls us to pray (Jeremiah 33:3)
      - Knowing our need, He asks what we want (Mark 10:51)
    - 3. Who promises much
      - He hears! In secret!
      - He answers and rewards "abundantly" (Ephesians 3:20&21)
