- 1. JESUS' ENEMIES REMEMBERED JESUS' WORDS AND FEARED (27:62-64).
 - a. Jesus' enemies gathered before Pilate once again (27:62).
 - b. Jesus' enemies remembered Jesus' prophesy (27:63).
 - (1) The Jews addressed Pilate as "Sir," that is, "Lord."
 - (2) Jesus' enemies remembered Jesus' words about resurrection more than Jesus' disciples!
 - c. Jesus' enemies urged Pilate to make Jesus' grave secure (27:64).
