## "Walk In The Spirit!" Galatians 5:16-18

## Introduction:

- 1. Please Go Back With Me In Your Bibles To:
  - Galatians 5:
    - Where, Most Recently, We Have Been Looking At:
      - The Christian's Liberty That Is Made Possible:
        - Through The Gospel!
  - It Is A Liberty & A Freedom:
    - To Live According To:
      - The Love Of Jesus Christ!
        - Remember This? In Galatians 5:13-14 "For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. / For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself!"
  - But How Many Of Us Are Living:
    - According To This Principle?
      - How Many Of Us Are Living Every Day To:
        - "By Love Serve One Another?"
- 2. All Too Often:
  - Our Own Lives Look Like:
    - What Was Going On In The Galatian Churches:
      - 5:15 "But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another!"
        - There Was A Whole Lot Of "Biting & Devouring" Going On!
          - A Whole Lot Of Conflict & Strife!
  - How Often Is There:
    - Conflict & Strife:
      - In Our Lives Instead Of Love?
        - At Home / At Work / At School / Even At Church!
    - And How Much Selfishness Is There:
      - Instead Of Christ-Like Service?
  - So What Is The Solution?
    - How Can A Christian Look & Live:
      - More & More Like Christ?
        - The Solution & The Answer Is Provided In The Verses We Will Look At This Morning:
- 3. 5:16-18 "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. / For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. / But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law!"
  - If You As A Christian:
    - Are Struggling In Your Life:
      - To Look More Like Christ!
      - To Live More Like Christ!
      - And To Love More Like Christ!
  - Then You Need To In The Words Of 5:16:
    - "Walk In The Spirit!" (2x)
      - And Every True Christian Has The Freedom & The Responsibility To Do So!
  - And So This Morning:
    - We Are Going To Look More Closely At:
      - What It Means To:
        - "Walk In The Spirit!"
- \* First There Is:
- 1. A Responsibility To Walk In The Spirit!
  - See This In 5:16 "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh!"
    - Many Times We Live Our Lives Like:
      - The Galatian Churches:
        - According To The "Way Of Flesh!"
          - Our Own Way!

- And Like The Galatians:
  - It Doesn't Turn Out Well Does It?
    - So Instead All Throughout This Letter Paul Is Telling Us To Follow The "Way Of Faith" Instead!
  - And This Is How You Do It:
    - You: "Walk In The Spirit!"
- Every Christian Has A Responsibility To "Walk In The Spirit!"
  - But Have You Ever Wondered What This Means?
    - And If It Is So Important & So Necessary, How Can I "Walk In The Spirit!"
      - Need To Remember That:
- It Is A Spiritual Walk!
  - The "Spirit" That Paul Is Talking About Here:
    - Is Not Your Human Spirit:
      - But The Holy Spirit Of God!
        - And Paul Has Already Introduced Us To The Holy Spirit In This Letter!
    - 3:2-3 "This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? / Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?"
      - Here We See The Reception Of The Holy Spirit:
        - In The Life Of Every Christian, Through Faith!
      - You Can Only "Walk In The Spirit" If:
        - You Have Been Regenerated By The Holy Spirit & Have Received The Holy Spirit Through Faith In Jesus Christ!
      - So Before You Can "Walk In The Spirit" You Need To Respond To The Gospel Of Jesus Christ!
        - Have You? When You Do:
    - 4:6 "And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba. Father!"
      - Here We See The Relationship That The Holy Spirit Confirms In Every Christians Heart & Life!
        - That You Are A Child Of God!
    - So To "Walk In The Spirit" (5:16) Means:
      - That We Are Walking In Step With The Holy Spirit Of God:
        - Who Has Been Given To Every Christian!
        - And Who Even Indwells Every Christian!
    - There Is Not A Single Christian On Earth:
      - Who Does Not Have The Holy Spirit With Him Or Her!
        - And So We Have A Responsibility To "Walk" With Him & In Him!
  - But What Does It Mean To "Walk In The Spirit"?
    - To "Walk" Mere Means To Live Your Life:
      - Your Whole Life Under The Influence & Direction Of The Holy Spirit!
    - And The Illustration Is Like When You:
      - "Take A Walk!"
        - Walking Has Some Great Health Benefits! But Whether Your Walk Is Long Or Short - There Is Always:
    - A Purpose For Your Walk!
      - Could Be For Health / "Get Your Steps In"
      - Could Be To Walk the Dog / Go To The Store / Visit Someone / Or Even Just For Fun & Scenery & To Breath In The Fresh Fall Air!
        - When You Walk Also:
    - A Plan For Your Walk!
      - Do Things Differently:
        - Depending On Your Walk!
      - If It's A Long Vs. Short Walk:
        - Different Shoes / Different Supplies!
      - If Its Cold Vs. Hot:
        - Different Clothes!
      - If Its To Be Fast Vs. Slow:

- Different Directions!
- When You Walk Also:
- A Path For Your Walk!
  - Sometimes Straight & To The Point!
    - Other Times Doesn't Matter!
  - Sometimes The Path Is Clear:
    - Other Times Make Your Own Path!
  - When You Walk Also:
- A Progress For Your Walk:
  - There Comes A Point When:
    - Your Walk Is Going To Come To An End! Have A Destination!
      - Even If It Is A Point To Turn Around & Return Home!
  - With Every Step:
    - Get Closer To Your Destination!
  - When You Walk Also:
- A Power For Your Walk!
  - Usually Your Own Two Legs!
    - But Have You Ever Went To Walk Your Dog And Instead Your Dog Walked You!
  - Sometimes Hard To Control Where They Want To Go!
- Whenever You Take A Walk:
  - It Is Based On Your Own Desires!
    - Based On Your Own Purpose / Plan / Path / Progress / Power!
- But When You "Walk In The Spirit" Your Whole:
  - Life's Walk:
    - Is Different! Is New!
      - Romans 6:4 "Even so we also should walk in newness of life!"
  - The Purpose Of Your Life:
    - And Every Step Of Your Life:
      - Can Now Be Under The Direction & Influence Of God Through The Holy Spirit!
  - Instead Of Your Own Plan & Path:
    - You Strive To Follow After:
      - God's Plan & Path For Your Life!
  - And Even The Progress & Power Of Your Life:
    - You Rely Upon Him!
- Is This What Your Live's Walk Looks Like?
  - Are You "Walking In The Spirit?"
    - Every Day, Surrendering Every Part Of Your Day & Your Walk:
      - To The Lord & To His Spirit?
  - Every Christian Has The Responsibility:
    - To "Walk In The Spirit!"
      - And Every Christian Has Been Given The Holy Spirit:
        - To Walk In!
  - So It Is Possible To Live Your Life This Way!
    - It Is A Spiritual Walk! Governed! Also:
- It Is A Successful Walk!
  - 5:16 "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh!"
  - The "Lusts Of The Flesh" Are:
    - Those Sinful Desires That Remain:
      - In Our Lives Even After We Are Saved!
        - The Desires Of The "Old Man!"
    - It Is The Desire To Follow Our:
      - Own Way Without Regard To God / The Gospel / His Grace!
  - But If You "Walk In The Spirit Ye Shall Not Fulfill The Lusts Of The Flesh!"
    - Now That's The Definition Of Spiritual Success!
      - And Isn't This The Desire Of Every True Christian?
  - Shouldn't It Be?

- To Be Holy Even As God Is Holy!
  - To Be Rid Of The Sin That So Easily Besets Us!
    - Not By Following The Letter Of The Law But In And Through The Power Of The Holy Spirit Of God!
- This Should Be Our Desire:
  - Because It Is God's Desire For Our Lives!
    - And He Only Wants What Is Best!
      - And The Holy Spirit Is The Only One Who Can Give Us The Freedom From Our Own Flesh So That We Can Look & Live & Love More & More Like Jesus Christ Himself!
- So "Walk In The Spirit!"
  - We Do This:
    - Not By Ignoring The Holy Spirit:
      - And His Will For Our Lives!
  - But By Being Daily / Constantly:
    - Influenced By The Holy Spirit!
  - And This Is The Responsibility & Possibility:
    - Available For Every Christian / Child Of God!
      - Also:

\* There Is:

## 2. A Reason To Walk In The Spirit!

- 5:17 "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would!"
  - Paul Gives Us A Major Reason Why:
    - We Need To "Walk In The Spirit!"
      - Not Only For Spiritual Success!
        - But Also Because Of The Spiritual War That Is Going On In The Heart Of Every Christian!
          - It Is:

- A Personal War!
  - "For The Flesh Lusteth Against The Spirit!"
    - Paul Puts This As The Major Reason Why We Need To "Walk In The Spirit" Continually!
      - Now It's Not Just "The Flesh" That Is At War With The Holy Spirit:
        - But My Flesh & Your Flesh!
          - Very Personal!
  - Paul Understood This & Felt This Very Acutely:
    - Romans 7:14-24 "For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin. / 15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. / 16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good. / 17 Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. / 18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not. / 19 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do. / 20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. / 21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. / 22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: / 23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. / 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?"
  - Do You Feel This Same Struggle In Your Own Life?
    - Its Because "Your Flesh Lusteth Against The Spirit!"
      - It Always Has & Always Will, This Side Of Heaven! Now That Could Be Very Discouraging / Even Distressing / But Wait, There's More! It Is Not Only Personal, But:
- A Promising War!
  - Romans 7:24-25 "O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death? / I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin!"
    - Jesus Himself Has & Will Deliver You From "The Body Of This Death!"
  - Galatians 5:17 "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh!"

- Although Your Flesh Fights Against The Spirit:
  - The Holy Spirit Of God Is Fighting Against Your Flesh!
    - And That's A Gracious Promise For Every Believer In Christ!
- Victory Over Your Sin & Your Own Flesh:
  - Is Assured & Is Still Ongoing! Also:
- A Persistent War!
  - 5:17 "And these are contrary the one to the other!"
    - It's Not Just The Lusts & Desires:
      - That Are Opposed To Each Other!
  - It Is Our Flesh & The Holy Spirit Themselves!
    - And That Is Why We Must Not Give In:
      - To The Pressures Of Our Own Flesh!
  - They Are Each:
    - Standing In The Way Of The Other!
      - But This Was Not Always The Case!
        - Before A Person Comes To Christ, Ruled By Our Unrestrained Flesh!
          - And No Struggle Meant No Salvation!
  - But Now The Holy Spirit Is:
    - Set Against My Sinful Flesh:
      - To Restrain Me & To Rescue Me From Its Residual Power & Strength Over Me!
        - A Continuing Battle / Struggle!
  - This Is Why We Need To Keep:
    - "Walking In The Spirit!" Also:
- A Powerful War!
  - 5:17 "So that ye cannot do the things that ye would!"
    - This Battle Within Us Affects:
      - Not Just Our Minds & Wills:
        - But Also Our Actions!
    - In The Life Of A Christian:
  - There Are Times When:
    - You Really Want To Please God! (Hopefully, Most)
      - But Then Your Old Flesh Gets In The Way!
        - And If You Are Not Walking In The Spirit:
          - Then It Gains The Advantage In Your Life!
    - And You Try To Live Your Life Under Your Own Power & With Your Own Efforts!
      - What Does This Lead To?
        - All Christians Experience It!
          - Frustration / Failure!
  - But There Are Also Times When:
    - You Really Want To Please Yourself!
      - And You Are Tempted To Sin!
        - But Then The Holy Spirit Steps In The Way!
          - And If You Are Walking In The Spirit He Gains The Advantage!
    - And Delivers You From That Temptation & Sin:
      - And Gives You The Victory!
- So Even Though This War Continues In The Life:
  - Of Every Christian There Will Be Progress!
    - Remember It's A Walk!
    - So Don't Be Frustrated! Instead:
      - Keep "Walking In The Spirit!"
        - And Then You Will See:
- 3. The Reality Of Walking In The Spirit!
  - 5:18 "But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law!"
    - As A Christian: If You Are Walking In The Spirit:
      - Then You Are:
  - Following The Leadership Of The Spirit!
    - "But If Ye Be Led Of The Spirit!"

- Often Seems Like A Mysterious Phrase!
  - "Spirit Led Me!"
    - But Is It? No! Truth Is:
- You & I Can Only "Walk In The Spirit" If:
  - We Are Being "Led Of The Spirit!"
    - And If You Are A Christian:
      - You Are "Led Of The Spirit!"
- Romans 8:14 "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God!"
  - If You Are A Christian:
    - You Are Being "Led Of The Spirit!"
      - But Often Wonder How?
- It Is A Constant Leadership!
  - There Never Is A Time In Your Life:
    - When You Are Not Being Led By The Spirit! Happens All Through Life! Also:
- It Is A Consistent Leadership!
  - With His Character As The Holy Spirit!
  - He Leads Us From:
    - Unholiness & Sin Always!
  - He Leads Us To:
    - Jesus Christ Always!
  - He Leads Us On:
    - The Paths Of Truth & Righteousness:
      - And Faith Always!
  - He Leads Us By:
    - His Word Always!
      - Which He Can Use To Influence Our Minds & Our Memories & Our Conscience!
- To Walk In The Spirit Means:
  - That You Are Following The Leadership:
    - Of The Holy Spirit!
      - And Relying On His Power & Strength To Do So!
        - Also Means That You Are:
- Following The Liberty Of The Spirit!
  - "Ye Are Not Under The Law!"
    - You Now Have The Freedom:
      - To Follow The Spirit & To Walk In The Spirit!
  - You Are Not Forced To Do So:
    - From The Outside:
  - But Instead You Are Free To Do So:
    - From The Inside:
      - Stirred & Prompted By The Holy Spirit Of God!
        - Isaiah 30:21 "And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left!"
  - God's Will Becomes More & More Our Own Will!
    - And So We Follow His Leadership:
      - Willingly!
- This Is The Reality Of Walking In The Spirit:
  - When You "Walk In The Spirit" You Are:
    - Following The Spirit!
      - His Leadership & The Liberty He Provides!
  - 2 Corinthians 3:17 "And where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty!"

## Conclusion:

- 1. So Conclude With This Question:
  - Are You Walking In The Spirit?
    - Today & Every Day?
      - There Needs To Be A Daily Application Of This In Our Lives!
  - It Isn't Meant To Be Some Mysterious Thing:

- Or Even Some Impossible Ideal!
  - Because The Truth & Reality Your Christian Life Is This:
    - You Are Being Led Of The Spirit!
      - Every Christian Is!
      - Because You Are God's Child!
- So To Walk In The Spirit:
  - You Just Need To Follow His Leadership:
    - And Direction & Influence!
      - We Will Learn More About This In The Next Few Weeks:
- 2. But For This Morning:
  - Remember Every Day To:
    - "Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh!" (5:16)
