## BY GRACE THROUGH FAITH

Ephesians 2:1-10

- I. <u>WE WERE</u> (1-3; 1 Cor 2:14; Col 3:5-7; Tit 3:3)—without Christ we *would be* 
  - A. <u>Spiritually Dead</u> (Gen 2:17; 2 Cor 15:22)—unable reform or recover; helpless
  - B. <u>Disobedient</u> (Tit 3:3)—rebellious, not obeying God, acting as His enemies
    - **1.** <u>Following the World</u> (Jn 15:18-19; Jam 4:4; 1 Jn 4:5; 1 Cor 2:14)—makes us enemies of God
    - 2. <u>Serving the Devil</u> (Jn 8:44; 12:31; 14:30; 2 Cor 4:4)—deceitful, cruel master
      - **a.** <u>Following</u> —prince of the power of the air—ruler of this fallen world in opposition to God
      - b. Being <u>used by</u> him—He works on, in and through his slaves
    - **3.** <u>Indulging Sinful Desires</u> (1 Thes 4:3-8; 1 Jn 2:15-16; Gal 5:16;)—contrary to God's character and the Holy Spirit's presence
      - a. Living in passions of our flesh
      - b. Carrying out desires of the body and mind
  - **C.** <u>Deserving Wrath</u> (Rom 1:18)—there but for the grace of God...
- II. <u>BUT GOD</u> (4-7)
  - **A.** <u>His Nature</u> (4-5a; Ps 103:8-12, 17; Jn 3:16; 15:13)
    - 1. Rich Mercy (Lk 6:36; 2 Pet 3:9; Jam 1:20)—not just a little!
    - 2. Great <u>Love</u> (Jn 15:13; Rom 5:8; 1 Jn 4:8-10; Jer 31:3)—not average!
  - **B.** <u>His Action</u> (5b-6)
    - 1. Made us alive —a miracle of God; He raised the dead!
    - 2. Raised us up —enemy w/o prospect to sitting w Jesus at God's right hand!
    - 3. Seated us in heavenly places—spiritually our position now
  - C. <u>His Motive</u> (7; 2 Sam 9)—loving kindness
  - **D.** <u>His Agent</u> (6-7)—we did not earn any of these favors; *Jesus* did it *for us*!

## III. OUR SALVATION (8-9)

- **A. By Grace** (Rom 3;24; 11:6; 2 Cor 8:9; Tit 3:7)—undeserved favor; God's work of redemption through the sacrificial atonement of Christ
- **B.** <u>Through Faith</u> (Jn 1:12; 3:15-16; Rom 4:16; 5:1-2)—saving faith is hearing, understanding, believing, calling upon Christ for salvation, embracing Him as Lord
  - 1. The means by which we appropriate what God offers
  - 2. Takes place in the <u>heart</u> (Rom 10:9-10)—intellect, affection and will
  - **3. Given by the Holy Spirit** (8b; Jn 14:17)
    - a. He regenerates (Jn 1:12-13; 3:5)—brings from spiritual death to life
    - **b.** He gives spiritual sight (Jn 3:3; 2 Cor 4:4, 6)—to see, recognize
  - 4. Produces action (Heb 11; Jam 2:17-24)—responds, acts in accordance with
- C. The Gift of God (Rom 3:23; 4:4; 6:23)—grace itself and faith to receive it
- **D.** What It Is NOT—not something we are capable of achieving
  - 1. Not your own doing (Eph 1:4,5,11)—or even your own choosing
  - **2. Not by your works** (Rom 3:27-28; 4:4; Gal 2:16; Tit 3:4-5)—Jesus had to earn it for us
  - **3. Not <u>conducive to pride</u>** (Jer 9:23-24; Rom 4:2-8; 1 Cor 1:27-31; 2 Cor 10:17)—no one can boast
- IV. OUR WORKS (10; Tit 3:5-8; Jn 15:5; )—result, not cause of our salvation
  - A. We are God's workmanship (Ps 100:3)—God gets glory for beautiful saints
  - B. Created for Good Works (Tit 3:8)—God's purpose, design, plan
  - C. <u>God prepared in advance</u> (Est 4:14; Isa 44:28)—us and particular works for us
  - **D.** That we should walk in them (Ex 20:2; Rom 6:13, 19)—already saved, now walk this way

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
