II. AN OBSERVATION OF TODAY'S PARTICULARS

v20, The Prophetic Priority of Faith

A. Background of Text

Genesis 27:1-40

- a. the promise to Isaac, Gen 26:3-4
- b. the palate of Isaac, Gen 27:4
- c. the preparations of Rebekah, Gen 27:5-17 (Gen 25:22-23)
- d. the precious picture of Christ, Gen 27:18-25
- e. the pronounced prophecy of Christ, Gen 27:26-29 (vv27-29)
- f. the perfect assessment of man's spiritual lack, Gen 27:30-40
 - i. vv19-40, in particular

B. Breakdown of Text

- a. Jacob's future blessing accurately depicts the blessings of Christ
- b. Esau's future blessing accurately depicts man's need for Christ
- c. Isaac's faith was awakened through godly fear (Gen 27:33)
- d. Isaac's faith was affirmed when he blessed Esau (Gen 27:39-40)

III. AN OCCASION FOR CELEBRATION BY THESE TRUTHS

- A. faith is sometimes awakened in the providence of our circumstance
- B. faith, working contrary to our expectations, fulfills God's Word & plan
- C. faith finds Christ Jesus at the center of our situation for our highest good
