1. Devoted Worship

We come first and foremost to honor – not primarily to receive...

2. Honest Help-Seeking

Cast you cares upon the Lord, for He cares for You.

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God...

When you pray – say: Our Father, who is in heaven... Hallowed be Your name...
