"The Reason For Our Riches" 2 Corinthians 9:6-11

Introduction:

- 1. Every Year Forbes Magazine:
 - Publishes A Detailed List:
 - Of The Richest People In The World!
 - They Are Described As "The Members Of The Three-Comma Club" Which Means:
 - That They Are All *Billionaires!*
 - The List For 2018 Includes:
 - 2.208 Billionaires Who Have A Combined Worth:
 - Of Over \$9 Trillion!
 - And That's A Lot Of Money!
 - That's Real Wealth Or So It Seems!
 - But Listen To What Paul Tells Timothy:
 - In 1 Timothy 6:17 "Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in *uncertain riches*, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy!"
 - The Riches That Forbes Magazine Celebrates:
 - Are "Uncertain Riches!"
 - That Is They Can Be Here Today:
 - And Gone Tomorrow!
- 2. But Remember What Jesus Taught:
 - In His Sermon On The Mount? In Matthew 6:19-21:
 - Jesus Said "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: / But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: / For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also!"
 - So We See That:
 - There Are Earthly Riches:
 - And There Are Heavenly Riches!
 - There Are Riches That Are Uncertain & Corruptible:
 - And There Are Riches That Are Certain & Incorruptible!
 - So It Is Clear That God Measures Wealth:
 - Quite Differently Than We Often Do!
 - But According To God's Standard:
 - Christians Are The Richest People In The World!
 - In Fact In The Verses We Will Look At This Morning:
 - From 2 Corinthians 9 We Are Told That:
 - We Have Been "Enriched In Every Thing!"
 - And Now There Is A Reason For Our Riches As Christians!
- 3. So If Your Not There Already Please Open Your Bibles With Me:
 - To 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 Where We Read "But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. / 7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. / 8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: / 9 (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever. / 10 Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) / 11 Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God!"
 - Here Paul Is Continuing To Encourage:
 - The Corinthian Christians:
 - To Give To The Special Collection:
 - For The "Poor Saints Which Are At Jerusalem!" (Romans 15:26)
 - This Was A Great Opportunity:
 - To Show Their Unity, Their Love & Their Service For Their Fellow Christians:
 - And Paul Told Them To Finally Finish The Offering:
 - With The Same Eagerness & Enthusiasm They Had Before!

- And The Key Reason Why They Could Do This:
 - We Find In 9:8 It Was Because:
 - "God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work!"
- 4. This Morning You Too Need To Remember:
 - That As A Christian / As A Child Of God:
 - You Are Rich!
 - Maybe Not According To The Way The World Measures Wealth!
 - But According To The Way God Does You Are Rich!
 - Because:
 - The Root Of Your Riches:
 - Is God Himself And His Abundant Grace!
 - According To 9:8 It Is "God" Who "Is Able To Make All Grace Abound Toward you!"
 - This Means That **All** Of The Resources Of God:
 - Are Available To You:
 - If You Are His Child!
 - And His Resources Are:
 - Infinite & Inexhaustible!
 - Even As We Are Told In Philippians 4:19:
 - "But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus!"
 - And So As A Christian:
 - You Can Now Measure Your Wealth:
 - Not By What You Have:
 - But By What God Has!
 - So Remember If You Are A Christian:
 - You Are Rich!
 - But We Also Find In 9:8:
 - The Reason For Your Riches!
 - It Is So "That Ye . . . May Abound To Every Good Work!"
 - This Shows Us That The Riches We Have:
 - Are Not Necessarily Financial!
 - They Are The Resources Of God That Enable You To "Abound To *Every* Good Work!"
 - This Could Be Your Giving!
 - But It Includes All Of Your Activities & All Of Your Service For The Lord!
 - So What We Discover Here:
 - Is That God Pours His Abundant Grace:
 - Into Your Life So That You Might:
 - Pour It Back Out To Others!
 - This Is The Reason For Your Riches Whatever Form They May Take!
 - Is This How You Look At What God Has Provided To You?
 - Are You Pouring Out:
 - What God Has Been Pouring *In*:
 - To Your Heart & Life?
 - This Is The True Measure Of Christian Wealth!
 - Not What You Have!
 - But How You Give!
 - This Is Why Paul Also Shares With Us:
 - The Results Of Your Riches!
 - In 9:8 God Pours Out The Riches Of His Grace To You:
 - So That You Might:
 - Be "Always Having All Sufficiency In All Things!"
 - This Means That:
 - At All Times!
 - In All Things!
 - You Have All You Need!
 - For "Every Good Work!"

- This Means That:
 - Your Cup Will "Never Run Dry!"
 - Even As You Pour Out To Others What God Has Given To You!
 - But Even More:
- In 9:11 God Reminds Us:
 - That We Are:
 - "Being Enriched In Every Thing To All Bountifulness!"
 - This Means That:
 - Even Though It May Not Always Seem Like It At The Time:
 - You Have All You Need:
 - In Order For You To Give & To Serve!
 - Of Course, This Does Not Always Mean:
 - Financial Giving:
 - Even As Peter Acts 3:6 "Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee!"
 - So It's True You Never Can "Out-Give God!"
- 5. And Now Because Of These Truths:
 - About The Root Of Your Riches:
 - And The Results Of Your Riches From God:
 - You Are Now Free To Focus Your Undivided Attention On The Reason For Your Riches:
 - 9:8 "That Ye May Abound To Every Good Work!"
 - And In The Rest Of Our Verses This Morning:
 - We Find 4 Ways For You To "Abound To Every Good Work!"
 - As You Pour Out What God Has Poured In!
- 1. Pour Yourself Out In A Bountiful Way!
 - According To The Principle You See:
 - In 9:6 Where Paul Shares A Proverb About 2 Farmers:
 - 2 Different Sowers "But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully!"
 - The First Sower Is:
 - A Closed-Handed Sower!
 - That Is "Tight Fisted" He Sows "Sparingly" And In A "Miserly" & A "Half-Hearted" Way!
 - Now We're Not Sure Exactly Why This Farmer Sows His Seed In This Way!
 - It Could Be Because He's Lazy! Greedy! Discouraged! We Just Don't Know!
 - But No Matter The Reason:
 - The Principle Still Hold's True!
 - "He Which Soweth Sparingly Shall Reap Also Sparingly!"
 - But The Opposite Is Also True!
 - The Second Sower Is:
 - An Open-Handed Sower!
 - That Is He Sows "Bountifully!"
 - And The Word Translated "Bountiful" Here Is The Same Word For "Blessing" That We Looked At Last Week In 9:5!
 - He Sows His Seed:
 - Based On Promise Of Great "Blessing!"
 - This Farmer Is Positive & Optimistic, And Sees This New Season Of Planting As A New Opportunity:
 - For A Bountiful Harvest!
 - And As A General Rule He Is Right!
 - "He Which Soweth Bountifully Shall Reap Also Bountifully!"
 - And This Principle:
 - That Works In The Natural World:
 - Is Also At Work In The Spiritual World!
 - There Is No Reason For You To Sow "Sparingly"
 - Because God Is The One Who Provides All The Seed You Need!
 - Instead You Can Sow & Give & Serve:
 - In A Bountiful Way With All You've Got!

- This Is Why Paul Tells Us Further In Galatians 6:9 "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not!"
- Are You Sowing & Sharing:
 - What God Has Given You:
 - In A Bountiful Way?

2. Pour Yourself Out – From A Willing Heart!

- According To The Pattern You See:
 - In 9:7 "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver!"
 - This Is Always How God Wants His People To Give!
 - Out Of A Willing Heart!
 - "As He Purposeth In His Heart!"
 - And God Is After Your Heart! So:
- Do Not Give Or Serve:
 - From The Pain Of Loss!
 - Or "Grudgingly" Reluctantly Regretfully!
- Do Not Give Or Serve:
 - From The Pressure Of Others!
 - Or "Of Necessity" Compulsion Feeling Like It Is A "Have To" Instead Of A "Get To!"
 - Instead:
- Give And Serve:
 - For The Pleasure Of God!
 - "For God Loveth A Cheerful Giver!"
 - This Means That:
 - "God Blesses, Loves, Delights In, The Joyous Giver!" (Hodge)
- And So As Christians:
 - Who Have Been Enriched By The Grace Of God:
 - Beyond Measure We Need To "Feel It Is An Honor And A Joy To Give" And To Serve The Lord! (Hodge)
 - Are You Giving & Serving:
 - The Lord Willingly:
 - And From Your Heart?

3. Pour Yourself Out – In A Christlike Way!

- According To The Provision You Have:
 - Found In 9:9 Which Is A Direct Quote From Psalm 112:9 "As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever!"
 - Now The Entire Psalm From Which Paul Quotes:
 - Describes 112:1 "The Man That Feareth The Lord!"
 - And What That Man Is Like & What That Man Does!
- Now We Can Look At Psalm 112:
 - As Well As Paul's Quote In 2 Corinthians In Two Ways!
 - First It Describes What:
 - Every Christian Aspires To!
 - But Even More:
 - Second It Describes What:
 - Jesus Christ Alone Has Achieved!
 - And Now, He Becomes Our Example & The Only One Who Can Enable Us To Become Like Him!
 - And So This Quote In 2 Corinthians 9:9:
 - Shows Us How Jesus Christ Himself:
 - Has Poured Out His Grace To Us:
 - He Has Done So:

- Fully!
- "He Hath Dispersed Abroad!"
 - He Is Like The Second Sower In 9:6 He Has Scattered The Seed Of His Grace:
 - With An Open Hand To All!

- Matthew 5:45 "He maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust!"
- But Even More He Has Poured Out His Grace To Us:
- Freely!
 - "He Hath Given To The Poor!"
 - His Grace Is So Valuable & Rich:
 - It Cannot Be Earned! It Cannot Be Bought! It Can Only Be Offered & Given!
 - And This Is What Jesus Christ:
 - Has Done For Us Through The Gospel!
 - Remember 8:9 "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich!"
 - This Is Where It Must Begin!
 - Without Christ You Are:
 - And Will Forever Remain Poor:
 - Spiritually Poor And Lost Forever Because Of Your Sin!
 - But Through Christ And Faith In Him:
 - You Can Become Rich:
 - Spiritually And Eternally Rich!
 - Because Jesus Humbled Himself To Become Poor Like You & Like Me And To Sacrifice His Own Life For Your Sin!
 - But When Jesus Came Back To Life:
 - According To His Promise 3 Days Later:
 - He Did So, So That He Could Continue To Pour Out His Grace:
- Faithfully!
 - To All Those Who Believe In Him
 - "His Righteousness Remaineth For Ever!"
 - Because Jesus Now Lives, He Can Remain Forever Faithful:
 - To His Word & To His People!
 - O "What A Wonderful Savior Is Jesus My Lord!"
 - Is He Your Savior & Lord Today?
- If So Then Jesus Christ:
 - Can Enable You To Give & To Serve Others Like Him!
 - Fully! Freely! Faithfully!
 - According To His Own Unending Supply Of Grace!
 - Are You Living & Giving:
 - In A Christlike Way Today?

4. Pour Yourself Out – In A Dependent Way!

- According To The Prayer We Find In:
 - 9:10 "Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness!"
 - Other Translations Of 9:10 May Read A Bit

Differently, But This Verse Is Probably Best Read As A Prayer!

- Paul Is Demonstrating, By Spontaneous Prayer For The Corinthians, That In Order For Us To Give & Serve:
 - In A Bountiful Way!
 - From A Willing Heart!
 - And In A Christlike Way!
- We Must Depend Completely Upon The Lord!
- After All God Is According To 9:10:
 - "He That Ministereth Or Provides Seed To The Sower & Bread For Food!"
 - This Means That:
- God Is The Source:
 - Of All You Need / All You Have / And Even All You Give!
 - This Is Why You Don't Have To Be Like:
 - The First Sower In 9:6 Because:
 - God Is The Source Of All Your Seed!
 - God Is The One:

- From Whom "All Your Blessings Flow!"
 - As We Sang Earlier He Is The "Fount Of Every Blessing!"
 - But This Also Means That:
- God Is The Sustainer:
 - Of Your Life!
 - He Also Provides Your "Bread For Food!"
 - So You Don't Just Need The Lord:
 - For The Grain That You Might Use To Make Your Own Bread!
 - You Need The Lord:
 - For The Water & The Oil & The Fuel & The Fire & Even The Hands & The Strength That You Need:
 - To Make Your "Bread For Food!"
- And So You Must Never Forget:
 - That You Are Completely Dependant On The Lord
 - For Any Growth:
 - You Might Have And:
 - For Any Fruit:
 - You Might Bear!
 - God Alone Is The One Who Can:
 - "Multiply Your Seed Sown" And:
 - "Increase The Fruits Of Your Righteousness!" (9:10)
 - So Psalm 37:5 "Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass!"

Conclusion:

- 1. This Is How You As A Christian:
 - Can 9:8 "Abound To Every Good Work!"
 - You Need To Give & Serve & Pour Yourself Out:
 - In A Bountiful Way!
 - From A Willing Heart!
 - In A Christlike Way!
 - Yet Always Dependant On The Lord!
 - But You Can Only Do This:
 - When You Remember:
 - Just How Rich You Truly Are In Christ!
- 2. Are You Pouring Back Out:
 - What God Has Been Pouring In:
 - To Your Heart & Life?
- 3. George Muller Who Lived From 1805-1898:
 - Was A Man Who Never Forgot:
 - Just How Much Grace God Had Poured Out To Him:
 - To Save Him!
 - And So He Sought To Pour Himself Out, For The Lord And For Others!
 - And One Of The Greatest Burdens He Had:
 - Was For The Orphans In England!
 - In Fact He Was Eventually Able To Build Five Large Orphan Houses & Cared For Over 10,000 Orphans During His Lifetime!
 - And Yet When He Died He Was Penniless!
 - How Could This Be?
 - As God Poured Out His Grace To George Muller:
 - George Muller Poured It Back Out:
 - To Others!
 - George Muller Never Asked Anyone:
 - Directly For Money!
 - And He Never Took A Salary In The Last 68 Years Of His Ministry!
 - Instead He Trusted God To Put In People's Hearts To Send Him What He Needed!
 - He Never Took Out A Loan & He Never Went Into Debt!
 - Yet, Neither He Nor A Single One Of The Orphans He Cared For Ever Went Hungry!

- It Has Been Estimated That:
 - George Muller Had Prayed In More Than \$150 Million, In Today's Money!
 - But He Gave It All Back In Service For The Lord!
 - And This Is The True Measure Of Christian Wealth!
 - Not What You Have!
 - But How You Give!
- 4. And This Is The Reason:
 - For Your Riches As Well!
 - To Pour Back Out What God Himself Has Poured In!
 - While You Rely On His Infinite & Inexhaustible Supply Of Grace!

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
