## OLD TESTAMENT

<sup>7</sup> I will declare the LORD's decree.  
He said to me, "You are my Son;  
today I have become your  
Father."

<sup>8</sup> Ask of me,  
and I will make the nations your  
inheritance  
and the ends of the earth your  
possession.

<sup>9</sup> You will break them with an  
iron scepter;

<sup>30</sup> But God raised him from the dead,  
<sup>31</sup> and he appeared for many days to those who came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people. <sup>32</sup> And we ourselves proclaim to you the good news of the promise that was made to our ancestors. <sup>33</sup> God has fulfilled this for us, their children, by raising up Jesus, as it is written in the second Psalm:

## 2 Samuel 7

<sup>8</sup> “So now this is what you are to say to my servant David: ‘This is what the LORD of Armies says: I took you from the pasture, from tending the flock, to be ruler over my people Israel. <sup>9</sup> I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have destroyed all your enemies before you. I will make a great name for you like that of the greatest on the earth. <sup>10</sup> I will designate a place for my people Israel and plant them, so that they may live there and not be disturbed again. Evildoers will not continue to oppress them as they have done <sup>11</sup> ever since the day I ordered judges to be over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies.

“ ‘The LORD declares to you: The LORD himself will make a house for you. <sup>12</sup> When your time comes and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up after you your descendant, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. <sup>13</sup> He is the one who will build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. <sup>14</sup> I will be his father, and he will be my son. When he does wrong, I will discipline him with a rod of men and blows from mortals.

## OT LXX DEUTERONOMY 32

<sup>43</sup> Rejoice, you nations,  
concerning his people, and let

his servants.

He will take vengeance on his  
adversaries;

he will purify his land and his

<sup>1</sup> My soul, bless the LORD!

LORD my God, you are very great;  
you are clothed with majesty and  
splendor.

<sup>2</sup> He wraps himself in light as if it  
were a robe,  
spreading out the sky like a canopy,

<sup>3</sup> laying the beams of his palace  
on the waters above,  
making the clouds his chariot,  
walking on the wings of the wind,

<sup>4</sup> and making the winds his  
messengers,  
flames of fire his servants.

<sup>5</sup> He established the earth on its  
foundations;  
it will never be shaken.

**3** Mighty warrior, strap your sword at your side.  
In your majesty and splendor—

**4** in your splendor ride triumphantly  
in the cause of truth, humility, and justice.  
May your right hand show your awe-inspiring  
acts.

**5** Your sharpened arrows pierce the hearts of  
the king's enemies;  
the peoples fall under you.

**6** Your throne, God, is forever and ever;  
the scepter of your kingdom is a scepter of  
justice.

**7** You love righteousness and hate wickedness;  
therefore God, your God, has anointed you  
with the oil of joy  
more than your companions.

<sup>10</sup> And:

**In the beginning, Lord,  
you established the earth,

**<sup>11</sup> they will perish, but you  
remain.**

**They will all wear out like  
clothing;**

**<sup>12</sup> you will roll them up like a  
cloak,  
and they will be changed like  
clothing.**

**But you are the same,

## PSALM 102

<sup>25</sup> Long ago you established the  
earth,

your hands.

<sup>26</sup> They will perish, but you will

all of them will wear out like  
clothing.

## PSALM 110

<sup>1</sup> This is the declaration of the LORD to my Lord:

<sup>2</sup> The LORD will extend your mighty scepter from Zion. Rule over your surrounding enemies.
