We learned previously in chapter 11 that John the Baptist was having doubts about Christ because He had not fulfilled the expectation that the Messiah would judge the wicked. Of course, Jesus will eventually come back as Judge and condemn the lost, and in our text today we learn that those in the most danger of severe judgment were those who had seen and heard what He was doing in Galilee.
