I. Paul and Silas in Thessalonica (17:1-9)

- A. The faithfulness of the missionaries (17:1-3)
 - i) Paul always began with the Scriptures
 - ii) Paul reasoned from the Scriptures
 - iii) Paul preached Christ from the Scriptures
- B. Fruits of the missionaries: sound church plant & persecution (17:4-9)

Jews & Gentiles believed & joined Paul & Silas (17:4) then persecution...

- i) The assault on Jason (17:5) dragged him from his house
- ii) Jason is arrested (17:6a)
- iii) The mob make accusation against Jason (17:6b-9)
 - i. Paul & Silas charged as troublemakers (6b-7a)
 - ii. Paul & Silas charged with treason (7b-9)

II. Paul and Silas in Berea (17:10-15)

- A. The Bereans' openness to God's Word (17:10-12)
- i. The Bereans *searched* the Scriptures (10-11)
- ii. The Bereans received the Scriptures with all readiness (12)
- B. The Jews stir up opposition to the Gospel and the Word (13-15)
