1) Satan – His Methods

QUESTIONS & COMMENTS:

If one is to overcome his enemy, he needs to know something of how he operates, and as much as possible of the methods he uses. Satan is the enemy of every believer. We took our first look in Lesson 11 at some of the more common ways Satan attempts to make people follow his will. We considered first the "Delusion Method". By confusing the mind, Satan blinds or deludes the person into disbelieving God's truth and into believing a lie. Let us look further at this first method.

SATAN-HIS METHODS

DELUSION METHOD (Continued from Lesson 11)

How does Satan persuade so many to follow him; what are his tricks? Even the Bible agrees that he is quite successful. What did John write concerning Satan which speaks of what he is able to do to the world?

Satan sometimes agrees that there is but one God. But there is a trick. He tries to make man believe
that the gods of Hinduism, Buddhism, etc. are just other names for the same God. Anyone who

Possibly no method of Satan is more used and more successful than the delusion method. The one delusion he uses so effectively concerns man's thinking that he has an endless number of tomorrows to do and be what God demands. Someone has said, "The Road to Hell is paved with good intentions." Getting one to wait until another time is one of Satan's oldest tools of delusion.
