## The Debt of Love Romans 13:8–10

Christians have a debt of love that is owed to all.

#### Owe no one anything

- This command does not forbid borrowing or having debt.
- This command does forbid being delinquent Psalm 37:21 The wicked borrows and does not repay, But the righteous shows mercy and gives.
- Do not fail to meet your obligations of debt including: civil, legal, societal, financial, family, moral, and spiritual.

#### except to love one another,

- Do not live in such a way that we owe others a sin debt, but live in such a way that we only owe them a love debt.
- Love is a debt that can never be completely paid but must be continuously paid.
- Christians have a permanent obligation to love others.

for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.

- No one can fully perform the works of the law without incurring a sin debt Romans 3:19–20; 7:14; Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are
  under the curse; for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO DOES NOT CONTINUE IN
  ALL THINGS WHICH ARE WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE LAW, TO DO THEM."
- Love is the righteous way to do the law.

For the commandments, "YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY," "YOU SHALL NOT MURDER," "YOU SHALL NOT STEAL," "YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS," "YOU SHALL NOT COVET," and if there is any other commandment, are all summed up in this saying, namely, "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF."

- The Ten Commandments are divided into two tablets. The first five commandments are the righteous obligation toward God and the second five commandments are the righteous obligation toward man.
- All the laws that cover our righteous obligation to others are brought together into one main commandment (Leviticus 19:18)
- Love everyone even enemies Matthew 5:43–47
- Love limits liberty Galatians 5:13–14
- Love is unbiased James 2:8–9
- Love outranks the other commandments Matthew 22:34–40

Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.

- Law is negative and meant to prevent violating and defrauding one another.
- Love always considers the needs of others and puts others ahead of self.
- Love is the whole content and the ultimate purpose of the law.

The Christian life can be summed up in loving God and loving others. Can we do that? 1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

The Petersons serve under Baptist Mid-Missions, and their sending church is in


