### CHRONOLOGY OF THE FLOOD

Event	Date	Reference
1. Noah entered the ark	Month 2, Day 10	Genesis 7:7-9
2. 7 days later: rain began falling	Month 2, Day 17	Genesis 7:10-11
3. 40 days later: heavy rains stopped	Month 3, Day 27	Genesis 7:12
4. 110 days later: prevailing waters receded, and the ark rested on an Ararat mountain	Month 7, Day 17	Genesis 7:24; 8:4
5. 74 days later: tops of mountains are visible	Month 10, Day 1	Genesis 8:5
6. 40 days later: raven sent out, and dove sent out and returned	Month 11, Day 11	Genesis 8:6-9
7. 7 days later: dove sent out again and returned with leaf	Month 11, Day 18	Genesis 8:10
8. 7 days later: dove sent out a 3rd time and did not return	Month 11, Day 25	Genesis 8:12
9. 22 days later: water receded	Month 12, Day 17	Genesis 8:3
10. Noah saw dry land	Month 1, Day 1	Genesis 8:13
11. Land completely dry; Noah exited the ark	Month 2, Day 27	Genesis 8:14-19
