An Exposé of a Wicked Man, Pt. 2

1 Thessalonians 2:15b-16 Study Notes for October 25, 2015

Introductory Remarks on "Pleasing"- understatement as well as a present tense

A Shocking Declaration: again, the focus here is on people in the church... sitting at this moment in church pews... who themselves think that they are pleasing to God! Think of it...

- 1. Throughout Redemptive and Church History pulpits have abounded with frequent allusions to the grace of God given to His people- like (Mt. 25:21; Rom. 8:1)...
- 2. As the body of Christ is comprised of both "wheat and tares" (Mt. 13:24-30), this message waters the entire vineyard, doesn't it? Accordingly, though the wicked amongst us in the body hear the message each week, we know that it is NOT intended for them; they are "tares"! What is a "tare"?
- 3. That is why this Second Fruit of the Wicked is so brutal... contrary to what they have heard throughout their time in church: (1) It is not well with their soul! (2) They are enemies of God! (3) They in fact are NOT pleasing to God. Cf., Jn. 8:43-44a; rom. 2:19-20, 23-24

The Expression, "They are not pleasing to God..."

The word for "pleasing" is ἀρέσκω ($aresk\bar{o}$) which originally meant "to be in a positive relationship with someone." It presupposes that all past relational transgressions are both known and forgiven!

~Hos. 3:1-3

Such is not the case for the Wicked! They have never been in a positive relationship with Lord. Though they participate in profound religious activities, nevertheless they are the object of God's wrath and hatred! As we saw last time: religious activity has been given by God to maintain/encourage our relationship with Him... NOT create it!...

*Point: Such is the Second Fruit of the Wicked! They are not Pleasing to God! But instead have as their expectation the wrath of God which is being stored up for "...the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, who will render to every man according to his deeds" (Rom. 2:5b-6)! With that, notice The Third Fruit...

3. As it Pertains to the World, vv. 15e-16a.

Hostile to All Men...

This is somewhat of a surprise. As we've seen, the Religious Wicked have a life that looks good, religiously. They fast, read, serve, give, and do many other things that look so good. Yet like Stained Glass

Windows, all they really do is keep the light out! And that is the point here...

"Hostile" Defined

The word for "hostile" literally means, "over against" (*en*, in, *antios*, against). It is used of a person standing directly in front of another (Mk. 15:39) or of an opposing wind (Mt. 14:24; Mk. 6:48; Acts 27:4). In fact, it is the latter that gives the true sense of this term...

~Mt. 14:24

Such is the Third Fruit of a Wicked Man: it is a vigorous, perilous, and brutal attack against ALL mennot just the genuine servant of God! How so? How is it that a religious pagan in the body of Christ is hostile to all men? Because the net-effect of their religion is...

Hindering

A very serious transgression, Mt. 10:41...

"Hinder Defined"

The word for "hinder" speaks not of a *prevention*, but an *impeding* of progress which speaks of varied and/or multifaceted attempts at compromising the gospel witness of genuine believers! In other words, the focus in this text is not necessarily *direct* formal restraint, but *indirect* forms of manipulation.

Examples: Today and no doubt in Paul's day wicked people in the body of Christ hinder the spread of the gospel...

- 1. By so occupying the genuine servant of God with attacks that the Christian is so busy with defense that they have limited opportunity for discipleship, evangelizing, and the nurture and care of the body of Christ.
- 2. By directly opposing any and every effort of bringing the gospel to the lost.
- 3. By corrupting the gospel message such that if a Gentile heard it they wouldn't be saved.
- 4. By compromising the fidelity of the genuine child of God through- alluring them with a false gospel or the ecstasy of religion (as in Baalism).

*Point: Such is the fruit of the Wicked actively working in the body of Christ today! Truly, sin has slain its thousands, but False Religion continues to slay its Ten Thousands! This is the Third and Final Fruit listed here: Hindering Gospel teaching/preaching that All Might be Saved!

*Where We Live

- 1. Zeph. 3:18 speaks of God gathering people who genuinely grieve about the state of the people of God in their day! I look around the church and am grieved and angered by the abuse that is evident to any with knowledge of the truth... and maybe so do you!
- 2. Yet hear this and be comforted! Though today wicked men and women remain in the church and continue to draw the church down, nevertheless let it be known that in the end they will render account for their deeds; they will be judged (Ps. 58:10-11; Jude 5, 10b, 11a, 13b; 2 The. 1:6-10)!
- 3. Are you amongst the Wicked? Remain no longer in the darkness, but heed the call of Is. 55:6-7...
