II. AN OBSERVATION OF TODAY'S PARTICULARS

v20, Grace, Faith & Sovereign Election

Texts to Consider: **Heb 12:15-17**; **Rom 9:13-16** (Mal 1:2-3)

- A. Faith as a Work?
 - a. faith's nature (substance, assurance) Heb 11:1

Gk. ὑπόστασις (hoo-POS-ta-sis) = concrete essence, confidence, assurance; used in **Heb 1:3** (nature, ESV; person, KJV) & **Heb 3:14** (confidence)

- b. faith as a gift, Eph 2:8-9
- c. faith exercised because of sovereign election, Eph 1:3-6
 - i. sovereign election helps reconcile some difficulties
 - unborn, infants in death, deaf, mentally incapacitated, etc.
 - ii. sovereign election implies true "age" of accountability, Eph 1:4
- B. Further illustrations for Our Understanding
 - a. David's utterance at the death of his son, 2 Sam 12:23
 - b. Elisha's inquiry of the Shunamite's son, 2 Ki 4:18-28
 - c. Jeremiah's appointment before conception, Jer 1:5
 - d. YHVH God's pity upon toddlers & cattle, Jon 4:11

III. AN OCCASION FOR PRACTICAL APPLICATION

- A. sovereign election doesn't mean all children will be saved, Eph 6:4
- B. sovereign election doesn't mean universal salvation, Rom 9:22-23
- C. sovereign election doesn't remove evangelistic responsibility, Deut 29:29
- **D. sovereign election** does promote assurance of salvation in the promises of an almighty and merciful Savior, **Rom 8:31-34**
