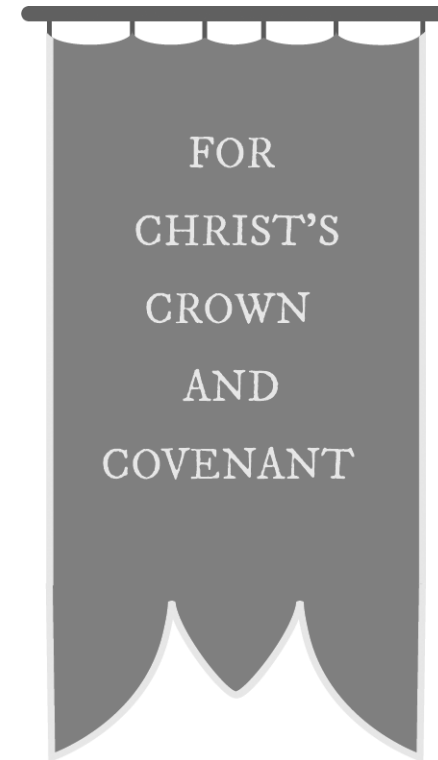

LARGER CATECHISM Q. 45: *How doth Christ execute the office of a king?*

A.
