

**A Help for the Sermon: Children, Check off when one of these verses are mentioned**

**NOTE: All of these verses are the Word of God, but are omitted in whole or part by modern Bibles**

Omitted Verses underlying Bibliology:

1. Unity across witnesses
  - a. Matt. 18:11 “For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.”
  - b. Mark 11:26 “But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.”
  - c. Luke 17:36 “Two *men* shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.”
  - d. Romans 16:24 “The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you all. Amen.”
2. Romans 11:6b “...But if *it be* of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.”
3. 2 Peter 1:21 “holy” men of God
4. Acts 23:9b “...but if a spirit or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God.”
5. Acts 13:42 “And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath.”

Omitted Verses underlying Epistemology:

1. The Supernatural
  - a. Mark 16:9-20
  - b. John 5:3b-4 “... waiting for the moving of the water. For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.”
2. Tradition
  - a. Acts 8:37 “And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”
  - b. Matthew 1:25: her “firstborn” son

Omitted Verses underlying Theology Proper:

1. Acts 14:15a “And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you...”
2. 1 Tim. 1:17/Jude 25 only “wise” God
3. 1 John 5:7 “For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.”

Omitted Verses underlying Christology:

1. Begottenness
  - a. John 1:14,18; 3:16. “... the glory as of the only begotten of the Father...No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*...For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...”
  - b. 1 John 4:9. “... because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world...”
  - c. John 8:42 “proceeded forth and came from God”
  - d. Hebrews 1:3 “express image of his person” vs “exact imprint of his nature” (ESV)
2. Deity
  - a. 1 Timothy 3:16 “...God was manifest in the flesh...”
  - b. John 3:13 Son of Man ‘which is in heaven’
  - c. John 7:8-10 ESV/NASB/NIV Makes Christ a Liar

3. Preaching Methods
  - a. Matthew 16:3 “...O ye hypocrites...”
  - b. Matt. 20:16 “So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen.”
  - c. Mark 7:16 “If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.”
4. Eph 5:30 “...of his flesh, of his bones”
5. John 7:53-8:11 The story of the woman caught in adultery

Omitted Verses underlying Soteriology:

1. Mark 10:24b “Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!”
2. Matt. 9:13 “for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.”
3. Luke 9:55-56a “But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of. For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save *them*...”
4. Keep Jews in Darkness
  - a. Mark 15:28 “And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors.”
  - b. Acts 28:29 “And when he had said these words, the Jews departed, and had great reasoning among themselves.”

Omitted Verses underlying Ecclesiology/Piety:

1. Fasting
  - a. 1 Corinthians 7:5a “Defraud ye not one the other, except *it be* with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer...”
  - b. Matthew 17:21 “Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.”
  - c. Mark 9:29 “And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.”
  - d. Acts 10:30 “And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing”
2. 1 Tim. 6:5 “from such withdraw thyself”
3. Matt. 6:13b “...For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.”
4. Instructions to ministers
  - a. Acts 15:34 “Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still”
  - b. Acts 24:6b-8a “...and would have judged according to our law. But the chief captain, Lysias, came upon us, and with great violence took him away out of our hands, commanding his accusers to come unto thee,...”

Omitted Verses underlying Eschatology: Hell/Judgement

1. Mark 6:11b “...Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.”
2. Mark 9:45b “...into the fire that shall never be quenched”
3. Matt. 21:44 And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.”
4. Mark 9:44,46 “Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.” breaks trinity of emphasis with 9:48
