The Holy Spirit's Pattern for the Church (Acts 2:42-47)

Two weeks ago we considered Peter's Pentecost sermon (2:14-41)

- 1. Peter's quotation of Joel and the Holy Scriptures' unity (2:16-21)

I. The Early Church was Devoted to Apostolic Teaching (2:42)

The first mention of the Spirit's presence in the church: Apostolic teaching
These new converts sat at the feet of the apostles receiving instruction
Word teaching "didache:" instruction but it also includes proclamation

II. The Early Church: Devoted to Fellowship (2:42, 44,45)

They devoted themselves to *fellowship*: bears witness to their common life Expresses what is shared together *fellowship* with *Father*, *Son & Holy Spirit* It expressed what we give as well

III. The Early Church: Devoted Formal & Informal Worship (2:42-47)

- A. Breaking bread (v.42)
- *B. Prayers* (v.42)
- *C.* The Holy Spirit manifested His power through the Apostles (v.43)

IV. The Early Church: Devoted to Evangelism (2:42)

- 1. The Lord (Jesus Himself) did it
- 2. He added to their number...those who were being saved
- *3. The Lord added people daily (v.46, 47)*
