## ONE IN CHRIST

Ephesians 2:11-22

- I. THE EXCLUDED (11-12)—Gentiles (heathen, lost, unchurched)
  - **A.** <u>The Attitude</u> (11; Deut 10:16; Jer 9:25-26; Rom 2:25-29; Phil 3:2-9; 2 Cor 2:11-13; Gal 5:6; 1 Cor 7:19)—disdain, disrespect, disgust
  - **B.** <u>The Status</u> (12)
    - 1. Separated from Christ—no Savior
    - **2.** <u>Alienated from Israel</u> (Rom 9:3-5)—not part of nation with whom God was in covenant relationship
    - **3.** <u>Strangers to the Covenants</u>—no legal relationship with God through covenant made with Abraham
    - 4. No Hope (1 Thes 4:13)—no certain hope for the future
    - **5.** Without God in the world (Acts 17:22-31; Rom 1:18-2:16; Gal 4:8)—no personal or official relationship of favor with God in this life
- II. THE BARRIER (14-15)—the division between Jews and Gentiles
  - A. The Dividing Wall of Hostility ()—animosity, offense
  - B. The Law of Commandments and Ordinances
    - **1.** The Covenant of Law (Ex 19:5; Lk 22:20; Heb 12:24)—Jesus established the New Covenant in His blood—based not on our obedience but upon His.
    - **2.** <u>Jewish Cultural Regulations</u> (Mk 7:19; Gal 5:6; Heb 9:9-10)—set them apart from the nations—they came to feel superior because of it.

## **III.** THE PEACE (13-17)—ended the animosity

- A. Who Made Peace (14; Jn 14:6; Acts 4:12; Rom 5:1)—Jesus IS our peace
  - 1. There is no peace with God apart from Jesus Christ.
  - 2. Peace is found in the person of Christ, not in our performance.
- **B.** How the Peace Was Made —the sacrificial atonement of Christ
  - 1. The Blood of Christ (13; Heb 9:22)—
  - **2.** <u>The Cross of Christ</u> (16)—reconciles God and humans as well as humans with one another
  - **3.** The Gospel of Christ (17)—the good news of forgiveness and reconciliation with God (and man)—Jesus brought the message

## IV. THE INCLUDED (Col 3:11)—

- **A.** One New Humanity (15,16)—neither Jew nor Gentile but Christian; the two have become one, something new
- **B.** The New Family (18-19)—members of God's household
- **C.** <u>The New Nation</u> (19a; Ex 19:6; 1 Pet 2:9)—the New Israel; fellow citizens with the saints
- D. The New Temple (20-22; 1 Pet 2:5)—God's dwelling place

## V. <u>APPLICATION</u>

- **A. Remember to be** <u>Thankful</u> **to God.** (Lk 10:20; Mk 5:19)—celebrate your salvation!
- **B.** Remember to be <u>Compassionate</u> to others. (Ex 23:9; Lk 6:31; 1 Pet 3:15; Heb 2:17-18)—one beggar telling other beggars where to find bread
