## Living Worthy of Christ's Calling, Part 2 "The Priority of Fellowship in the Body of Christ"

Ephesians 4:2-6

To live worthy of my calling, I must cherish and guard the unity of the Body of Christ!

1. The Spiritual Disposition Required in Cherishing and Guarding th	is Unity vv. 2-3
---	---------------------

(1) Characteristics (v.2)

"walk worthy...with all lowliness and gentleness with longsuffering

-1- Attitude of heart

bearing with one another in love"

- lowliness - Gk: tapeinophrosune

a lowly mind humility

- gentleness - Gk: prautes meekness

not self-willed

cf. our Lord's description of Himself: Matt. 11:29

## -2- Disposition toward others

- longsuffering patient in bearing with the offenses and injuries of others - to be mild and slow in avenging
- bearing with one another in love
- **(2) Priority** (v.3)

" endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."

- -1- Keeping, guarding the unity of the Spirit
  - a unity established by the Spirit of God
  - a unity which manifests itself in a bond of peace
  - a chief manifestation of the blessing of the Spirit cf. Ps. 133
- -2- We are called to seek those things which tend to peace among the brethren (Rom. 14:19)
  - e.g., a readiness to deal biblically with conflicts with a view to restoration and peace

## 2. Six Powerful Arguments for Cherishing and Guarding This Unity vv. 4-6

(1) We are one body!

"There is one body and one Spirit"

- constituted so by the Spirit of God
- members of each other!
- (2) We have experienced the same salvation!

"just as you were called in one hope of your calling"

- all of us were called out of darkness into light - all of us will share the same blessed future
- (3) We have one Lord!

"one Lord"

(4) We have one Confession!

"one faith"

(5) We have one true Identity!

"one baptism"

- all of us have been baptized into Christ
- all of us have been marked out by Christ as His own
- (6) We have one God and Father

"one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all."
