Because God Protects Genesis 31:17-32

God protects through His:

- **I.** Instruction "set his face toward... mount Gilead" (vs. 17-21) *Which reveals our:*
 - A. Duty "Then Jacob rose up"
 - B. Direction "to go to...the land of Canaan"
 - C. Deliverance "Jacob stole away unawares to Laban"
- II. Intervention "God came to Laban...in a dream" (vs. 22-25)

 Which results in:
 - A. Perception "it was told Laban on the third day"
 - B. Positioning "overtook him in the mount Gilead"
 - C. Prevention "Take heed that thou speak not"
- III. Insight "Speak not to Jacob either good or bad" (vs. 26-32) Which recognizes:
 - A. Pretense "I might have sent thee away with...songs"
 - **B.** Pride –"It is in the power of my hand to do you hurt"
 - C. Peccancy "For Jacob knew not that Rachel had stolen"

Sentence Sermon:
