

Samuel and Carol Fouchachon Joseph and Savannah Fouchachon

Samy Foucachon, the pastor of the Reformed church in Paris, Chapelle de Nesle, had two speaking engagements in Switzerland this Summer. He spoke at a church retreat then at a camp for French speaking university students. Ministry in the Chapelle de Nesle has been restricted due to government regulations in Paris for COVID. They were allowed to resume meeting in June and have been meeting since June 28. Because of social distancing requirements in church only half of the usual attendees have been able to come. There are normally about 60 in attendance which is the capacity of the place they have. Attendance since June has been about 30. In addition, they have not been able to have their mid-week Bible studies and prayer meetings.

The church office is not at the same location as where the church meets. They recently changed offices and found a place much closer to the church (8 minutes by foot) and it is a much larger office and will be an excellent place for small meetings. This was an important answer to prayer.

The City of Paris recently mandated that everyone has to wear a mask outside of their homes. There is also a curfew from 9:00 PM until 6:00 AM, except for those who work during those hours. It is difficult to function as a church with restrictions that keep people home and limit the numbers when they can meet.

Joseph Foucachon is music director. He and his wife, Savannah, had their second child and daughter (Lucie Eleanor) on July 15th, the day after Bastille Day. So, Savannah is a busy mother of two young daughters. J

Since the church meetings are small most of the musicians in the Chapelle de Nesle have not attended and some left town during the Summer. Joseph has been the only musician on most Sundays. He also arranges the music for major events for the church; a Reformation service and a Christmas service. These events are professionally done, open to the public and usually well-attended. However, this year they will not be allowed to have these events.

The Foucachons ask for prayer for the following: First, that this COVID epidemic will pass or abate enough that life can go back to normal. Second, that the strikes and violence of the "gilets jaunes" that disrupted life in Paris before the COVID restrictions will not return once the restriction are removed. Third, that the regular attendees of the past will return when the law permits. Fourth, the church needs to find a larger, permanent place for church meetings that has space for Sunday School classes and a nursery. They have been looking for six years but have not been able to find a place that they can afford to rent or buy. Fifth, Joseph and Savannah lost some of their support this year and are praying for more. Church Creek is able to continue their support at the same level but we are not planning to give increases to any of our missionaries this year.
