Welcome friends to another broadcast of "Morsels for Zion's Poor"

It is not difficult to get men to worship the gods of their own making and this is demonstrated guite clearly in what is called "modern christianity" which has no basis in fact, much less in the declaration of the gospel delivered by the ONE TRUE PROPHET sent from GOD, JESUS CHRIST the RIGHTEOUS.

How shall we escape destruction if we disregard the SALVATION which is declared by JESUS CHRIST himself and those whom HE has taught the same. This is a great salvation because it is:

HE said, "In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you.
