- We are fast becoming a "post Christian" nation.
- Jesus Christ as the "light of the world"
- You and I as the "light of the world"

"Light-like"?

- **A. As we separate from the world!** Ephesians 5:7; 4:17-20
 - "In" the world, but not "of" the world!
 - 2. To be an influence, we must be different from the world.

B. As we develop "Light-like" character qualities!

- Our focus is to be on personal holiness—1 Pet. 1:15-16
- 2. Separation from the world without corresponding development of personal holiness produces external religious legalism and internal, self-righteous hypocrisy! Case in point: The Pharisees
 - Separatists and legalists
 - Failed to develop internal holiness—Matt. 23:25-28
 - Hypocrites
- To be God's light-bearers, we must focus on developing "light-like" qualities. We need to "walk as children of light".
 - The **PROCESS**—Ephesians 4:20-24 "Put Off—Put In—Put On"
 - "Put Off"—Colossians 3:5, 8-9 "Put On"—Colossians 3:12-14

 - "Put In"—new "input"—Colossians 3:10
 - Veil removed when we come to the Lord—2 Cor. 3
 - b) Transformation process—2 Cor. 3:18
 - Process not finished until death—Phil 3:12-14
 - The **PRODUCT**—Ephesians 5:8-9 Three "light-like" qualities
 - "goodness"—Moral excellence, to others
 - "righteousness"—Spiritual excellence, to God 2)
 - 3) "truth"—Personal excellence, to oneself
 - The **PURSUIT**—Ephesians 5:10—"fully pleasing" Christ Colossians 1:9-10
 - Not through trial and error!
 - Through obeying God's Word and doing God's will
