



## The Results of the Spirit's Work

Galatians 5:26—6:5

- 1) What does the Spirit of God do in the believer?
  - a) He *baptizes* believers once and for all time (1 Cor. 12:13; cf. Matt. 3:11)
  - b) He *indwells* believers for eternity (Rom. 8:9-11)
  - c) He *seals* believers as a guarantee of their future redemption (Eph. 1:13-14; 4:30)
- 2) What is the behavior of those who possess God's Holy Spirit?
  - a) They *walk* in the Spirit (Gal. 5:16, 25)
  - b) They allow the Spirit to *fill* them (Eph. 5:18-21; cf. Col. 3:16-17)
  - c) They exhibit the *fruit* of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23)
  - d) They are *spiritual*, maturing in their faith (Gal. 5:26—6:5)
    - i) They are a *blessing* to their fellow Christians (Gal. 5:26)
    - ii) They bear the burdens of others in need, fulfilling the law of Christ (6:1-5)
      - (1) Being gentle, not judgmental (1a)
      - (2) Cautious about being tempted (1b)
      - (3) Viewing themselves properly (3)
      - (4) Examining their own work (4)
      - (5) Being responsible for their own life (5)
