I. CREATING A NEW PEOPLE FOR A NEW WORLD

- A. Creating the Messianic community John and his admonishing invitation and steps of action Repent, believe and be baptized (enter and identify), act on what you know and trust
- B. Recognizing the Messiah Jesus Christ, the Son of God
 - 1. Recognition by birth of John
 - 2. Recognition by His own birth
 - 3. Recognition by John
 - 4. Recognition by His Father and the Holy Spirit
 - 5. Recognition by Satan
- C. Messiah identifying with the new people of the Messianic community
 - 1. Born Israeli, son of David, fully human and fully divine
 - 2. Delivery from Egypt
 - 3. Raised in the Mosaic community under the law
 - 4. Baptized into the messianic community to be an living member of them by the appointed voice
 - 5. Tested in the wilderness to pass the test Israel had failed
 - 6. His life is already being a substitute for His community and will be given to them upon His resurrection
 - 7. It is His life in them that makes them new

II. JESUS' MESSAGE TO CREATE A NEW PEOPLE

- A. Proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom of God
 - 1. The love and grace of God
 - 2. The truth about God
 - 3. The call to follow Him as the Messiah
- B. It is the right time: God's prophecies of Messiah and the new covenant are fulfilled and ready for presentation; the condition of the people was such that this was seen as essential
- C. The kingdom of God was near; it is as close as the King Himself in their presence; it was a prayer of faith away!
 - 1. The kingdom of God is the restoration of the order of creation that had been disrupted by transgression and rebellion
 - 2. It is the rejoining of heaven and earth under the dominion of the Lord Jesus Christ; the ending of the death and rebellion brought on by the willful separation of man, and heavenly beings from God
 - 3. It is the new heavens and the new earth as God created them in the beginning to be lived in by a newly created people in perfect fellowship forever with God
 - 4. It is the re-union of God and man in relationship and fellowship that is identical to that shared by the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit
- D. To join this community requires a complete change of mind delivered by the persuasion of God in a surrendered humble hearer, trusting Jesus as Messiah, and that His work is sufficient to save.
