How to Fix an Achan Heart: The Big Battle with Self Joshua 7:1-26

- 1. How are we usually defeated (vs. 2-5)
 - Overconfidence or self confidence (vs. 2-3)
 - Lack of <u>preparation</u> (vs. 4-5a)
 - Lack of <u>understanding</u>. (v. 5b)
- 2. How can we discover the problem? (v. 6-15)
 - We can resort to prayer (vs. 6-9)
 - God will reveal the problem (vs. 10-15)
- 3. What is the extent of the damage? (vs. 16-26)
 - Sinners are <u>discovered</u> (vs. **16-18**)

Numbers 32:23 ...then take note, you have sinned against the LORD; and be sure your sin will find you out. 1 Corinthians 4:5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts.

Romans 14:12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

Sins are discussed (vs.19-21)

There is a progression to sin. (v. 21)

- (1) He saw what he shouldn't have seen
- (2) He coveted what he couldn't have
- (3) He took what was not permitted
- (4) He hid what he should not have taken
- Sinners are destroyed (vs. 22-26)
 - (1) Sinners pay for their sin
 - (2) So do their associations
- 4. Is there any hope of deliverance? (vs. 10-19)
 - There is always <u>room for repentance</u>
 Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will
 - have mercy.
 - There is an ample <u>supply of grace</u>
 Romans 5:20b But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more,
