Calvin's View of Preaching

- 1) Scripture is God speaking, thus Scripture speaks with Divine authority. The divine authority of the Word is above all, subject to none.
- 2) Scripture therefore must be taught, it must be expounded and applied for man's salvation and edification.
- Biblical preaching can be said to be the Word of God.
 Second Helvetic Confession, The preaching of the Word of God is the Word of God.

Calvin's images for preaching

- 1. The school of God
- 2. The ambassador

The requirements for preachers

- 1. He must be totally committed to the Bible.
- 2. He must be a scholar.
- 3. He must have a humility that bows before the sovereign Word.
- 4. He needs courage to proclaim the Truth.

The purpose of preaching

- 1. The glory of God
- 2. The transformation of our lives (sanctification or reformation according to the Word).
- 3. To witness to and present salvation
