 - 1. A seat at the table
 - 2. The best meal
 - 3. Her cup overflowed
 - B. She was blessed by the presence of the one who would redeem her
 - 1. Safety
 - 2. Abundance
 - 3. Peace
- II. Hope For The Future (18-23)
 - A. There was enough for more than just Ruth
 - 1. The grace she received was extended out to others
 - 2. She freely gave of what was given to her
 - B. There was enough for many days an ephah
 - C. There was hope for long-term blessing (the promise to work in the field all harvest)
 - D. There was hope of an ultimate redemption, which would include continued participation in the inheritance of the people of God
- III. Abundant Life (John 10:10)
 - A. The context of feeding and caring for sheep
 - B. There is one who only wants to bring ruin
 - 1. Fear, doubt, pain, sorrow, worry
 - 2. These things are not of humble, active faith
 - C. Jesus has come to give life life abundant
 - 1. Right now, and later
 - 2. There is a fullness to it
