- **Loved** by God, **chosen** by God
 - The tell-tale sign: the effective preaching of the Gospel the powerful work of the Spirit bringing conviction

Imitators and Proclaimers...

- Our lived and proclaimed faith
- The power of imitation | God --> Paul --> Thessalonians --> Macedonia and Achaia
 - o Received the word 1) in affliction 2) with joy
- The Thessalonian's proclamation ("word of the Lord sounded forth")
