1. God's Word and Prayer – title slide
2. We use it to learn truth
3. *Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name".* John 20:30-31
4. *"...all of us possess knowledge." This "knowledge" puffs up,..."* 1 Corinthians 8:1
5. We use it as a guide on how to live
6. *"Everything in the Scriptures is God's Word. All of it is useful for teaching and helping people and for correcting them and showing them how to live. The Scriptures train God's servants to do all kinds of good deeds."* 2 Timothy 3:16 (CEV)
7. *"We see that people are acceptable to God because they have faith, and not because they obey the Law."* Romans 3:28
8. *"And since it is through God's kindness, then it is not by their good works. For in that case, God's grace would not be what it really is—free and undeserved."* Romans 11:6
9. We use the Bible to know God and develop a relationship with Him.
10. *"A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink." (For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.) The Samaritan woman said to him, "How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?" (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.) Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." The woman said to him, "Sir, you have nothing to draw water with, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water?""* John 4:7-11 (ESV)
11. *"...the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."* Romans 6:23
12. *"And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent."* John 17:3
13. *"You search the Scriptures, because you think you will find eternal life in them. The Scriptures tell about me, but you refuse to come to me for eternal life."* John 5:39-40
14. God "gives" us the Bible for information – so we can grapple with Truth
15. God "uses" scripture for transformation – to make us new and show us how to love our world.
16. God ultimately "invites" us to read the Bible for revelation – so that we can know Him and experience Him now and forever!
17. *"Keep your servant from deliberate sins! Don't let them control me. Then I will be free of guilt and innocent of great sin. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer."* Psalm 19:13-14
18. *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."* Deuteronomy 6:5-7.
19. Pray worship like Exodus 15:11
20. *Who is like you, O Lord, among the gods? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in glorious deeds, doing wonders?"*
21. Pray surrender like Psalm 139:23-24
22. *"Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!"*
23. Pray encouragement like Psalm 139:13-14
24. *"You are the one who put me together inside my mother's body, and I praise you because of the wonderful way you created me. Everything you do is marvelous! Of this I have no doubt."*

25. Pray God's faithfulness like *Philippians 4:18*

26. *"And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus."*
