 - B. What were the reasons for the announcement of judgment?
 - 1. Only concerned with outward righteousness
 - 2. Love of religious practice without care for the well-being of others
 - 3. Concerned for good social standing
 - 4. Weighing people down with burdens they cannot bear (legalism)
 - 5. Not accepting the guilt and hypocrisy that legalism and a stance against the true word of God causes on others
 - 6. Keeping people from a proper, freeing knowledge of the truth
 - C. The Indictment The blood of the righteous preachers that have died and been persecuted will be brought against this generation
 - D. They sought to trap Jesus in His words
