

## THE WAKE OF THE FALL *Genesis 3:20-24*

### I. ADAM NAMED EVE IN \_\_\_\_\_ (*THE FIRST MOTHER*) 3:20

#### A. An Act of \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) Adam renamed his wife Eve (or Zoe in Greek), which sounds like the Hebrew word for \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) Adam did so b/c she was “the mother of all living,” but she had no children & was not \_\_\_\_\_

#### B. An Act of \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) Adam’s sin was rooted in unbelief, but now he demonstrated faith in God’s promise of a \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) Adam also believed Eve would bear children; perhaps he concluded Eve would bear the \_\_\_\_\_

#### C. An Act of \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) Adam changed his mind—he now trusted God, and changed his behavior—what he called \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) Adam also repented of his sin in failing to lead Eve when she offered him the forbidden \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Man has always been saved by \_\_\_\_\_ in the gospel but the gospel has been progressively revealed

### II. GOD CLOTHED MANKIND BY \_\_\_\_\_ (*THE FIRST CLOTHES*) 3:21

#### A. The Physical Level

- 1) When Adam & Eve sinned, they felt \_\_\_\_\_ in their unclothed state; God endorses this connection
- 2) God more fully clothed them: a \_\_\_\_\_ covered their torsos and reached at least to their knees
- 3) God mandated that priests wear \_\_\_\_\_ when they approached his altar—another connection
- 4) Our consciences in how we \_\_\_\_\_ and what we look at needs to be informed by these principles

#### B. The Spiritual Level

- 1) God made the tunics; this word is repeated in the creation accounts, but God had \_\_\_\_\_ His labor but now God labored again, not in creation but in \_\_\_\_\_ by clothing man because of their sin
- 2) Israelites would have connected the tunics & the skins of animals to the \_\_\_\_\_ in the tabernacle
- 3) They would have connected the dots that God killed these animals as a form of \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice
- 4) It was a far distant glimpse of \_\_\_\_\_ the Lamb of God who redeemed us by shedding His blood

### III. GOD \_\_\_\_\_ MANKIND OUT OF THE GARDEN (*THE FIRST EXILE*) 3:22-24

#### A. God Deliberated with Himself concerning Man’s \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) They are so concerned that man doesn’t eat of the Tree of Life they don’t even \_\_\_\_\_ the sentence
- 2) The little word “also” in v.22 indicates that Adam & Eve had \_\_\_\_\_ already eaten from the Tree of Life
- 3) God was merciful in not permitting them to eat: endless life under the curse would have been \_\_\_\_\_

#### B. God \_\_\_\_\_ Adam and Eve Out of the Garden

- 1) God sent man out of the garden to begin experiencing the \_\_\_\_\_ upon his sin: judgment must fall
- 2) V.24 states that God drove man out—this word has steel in it and implies \_\_\_\_\_ and banishment
- 3) Cherubim continually praise God for His \_\_\_\_\_ and here they guard the holiness of God
- 4) The counterpart to this part of the story is the exclusion of \_\_\_\_\_ from the New Heaven/New Earth
