Gen. 2:18-24

- A. God creates marriage as an intimate covenant relationship, as an inviolable one flesh union.
 - 1. A helper corresponding to him
 - 2. Leaving and cleaving
- B. The purpose for which God created this covenant marriage was to reflect His own relationship with His people, which has He described as an intimate covenant marriage.
 - 1. God's redemption and covenant with His people "joined them together."
 - 2. Explicitly stated Isa. 54:5; 1 Cor. 6:15-17; Eph. 5:22ff.
 - 3. The nature of sin (idolatry) becomes revealed through the infidelity and whoredom metaphors

Ex. 34:11-16; Deut. 31:36; Judges 2:16-17 Hosea; Ezek. 16/23
