

Always the Same Lie with Aliens **by Fred DeRuvo – Study-Grow-Know Ministries**

In the New Age movement, Lucis Trust, or any group like it, there is no need for a deity that is separate from the individual. This message, spread throughout humanity by the various channels already mentioned, intones that our divinity lies inherent within us. There is no need to actually seek this outside one's self. In fact, it is through meditation that we withdraw *into* ourselves to unlock and unleash the power of our own divinity, guided by the power of our mind that brings us to the realization that we are gods and helps us create that reality that will benefit all of mankind.

What Satan has always done is attempt to find a way that circumvents God. In the record of his sin (Isaiah 14 and Ezekiel 28), Satan strove to become God himself; to, in fact, take God's place. Succumbing to his own beauty and intelligence, he could not deal with the fact that he was a *created* being and would never be anything but *created*. This knowledge ultimately fueled the jealousy that Satan (Lucifer before his fall) harbored with an animosity that grew with each passing moment of time.

That animosity led him to openly rebel against God, taking 1/3 of the angelic host in that same rebellion. Lucifer could not overcome or overthrow God. He found out the hard way, yet continues that same work as Satan, the being who delights to devour those on earth (cf. 1 Peter 5:8).

The *Plan of God* as seen by those within the occult, the New Age movement, and other esoteric societies is a plan that is actually devoid of the God of the Bible. God has been avoided at all costs, being replaced by the god of this world.

What we are hearing today is no different from what Satan (through the serpent) stated to Eve. He told her then that once she ate of the forbidden fruit, her eyes would be open and she would be like a god. Satan plied her with promises of divinity.

There is some evidence to suggest that prior to the fall, Adam and Eve lived fourth dimensionally. We think of Adam and Eve merely being the perfect human specimens. Certainly, God would not create something that was below par. Adam and Eve looked human enough, talked as humans, thought as humans and did the things that human beings today do. However, up until the time that sin was found in them, they did all these things without sinning.

Once they sinned, things changed...*drastically*. There is the possibility that when Adam and Eve fell, the reason they opted to create clothing for themselves was due to the fact that there was something about their nakedness that created *panic*.

This led to the desire to cover their nakedness. But consider that while they may have been embarrassed to see one another naked, had they simply been naked prior to the fall they would merely be seeing each other *differently*, but outwardly, they would essentially still be the same. What changed would have been their *perspective*.

Consider though that maybe what changed was *more* than their perspective. Chuck Missler seems to come to the possible conclusion that both Adam and Eve may have been covered with some form of *light*. When they fell, that light went out. They realized that they were not only naked, but they were *missing* something entirely.

Missing that something is what caused them to feel that what they were previously “wearing” had to be replaced since it was no longer there. Thus, they quickly made clothing out of leaves.

When God finally entered the picture after the fall, one of the first questions He asked them was, “*who told you that you were naked?*” after hearing Adam admit that they hid from Him because they were afraid and naked (Genesis 3). After hearing Adam’s and Eve’s story (the serpent remained silent), God pronounced judgment.

Following the pronouncement of judgment, God then made clothing from some of the animals in the garden. I’m going to assume they were the type of animals that would later be used as sacrifices. With the skins of the animals, God created suitable clothing for Adam and Eve.

It seemed as though God was agreeing with Adam that the two needed to be *re-covered* because they had lost their original covering. Of course, God could have made the clothing because of the weather as well, knowing it was going to change.

Is this far-fetched? Not really, if we consider the fact that angels often appear in Scripture shining *brightly*. There is something uniquely interesting about God’s *unfallen* creatures that highlights the fact of their purity, which is described as a *bright shining light*.

Did Adam and Eve have some type of light emanating from them acting as a protective covering, or simply as a covering, which was God’s mark upon His creation? Certainly, if that was the case, then the fall would absolutely destroy that light covering. It destroyed a number of other things as well, and created other things.

It is very likely that the fall caused God to create *entropy*, which prior to the fall would not have existed. Entropy is what makes people old, causes sickness, and ultimately, ushers in death. Would that have existed before the fall? In a word, *no*, because God said that everything He had made was *good*.

But humanity has learned little. What Adam and Eve did then – trying to become like gods by leaving God out of the picture – is no different from what people do today.
