“Keeping quiet is not the mark of OT piety. OT piety makes a noise, either in lament and prayer or in thanksgiving and praise. There is something suspicious about a person keeping quiet...When things are wrong inside; they have a way of affecting our bodies. Only noise can bring an end to anguish and wasting, the vocal protest to Yahweh that the psalms keep modeling or the confession voiced in this psalm. These drive Yahweh to act and thus remove the reason for the lament and the cause of wasting. Silent confession will not do, either.” Goldingay
