Old Testament: Proverbs 11:2; 16:18-19; 29:23

Sermon Text: Luke 18:9-14

We do not fundamentally have a right perception of ourselves. The question we should be asking ourselves is, “Am I acceptable in God’s sight”?

- 1) Pride blinds us to our own condition (Luke 18:9)

- 2) Humility allows us to see ourselves as we truly are (Luke 18:13)

- 3) Only Humility allows us to embrace Jesus Christ as our righteousness (Luke 18:14)
